
SUBJECT: The Situation in Indonesia

REFERENCE: NSC Action No. 1879

The National Security Council, the Secretary of the Treasury, the Attorney General, the Director, Bureau of the Budget, the Chairman, Atomic Energy Commission, and the Federal Civil Defense Administrator, at the 359th NSC Meeting on March 20, 1958 (NSC Action No. 1879):

- a. Noted and discussed an oral briefing by the Director of Central Intelligence on the subject ["Significant World Developments Affecting U. S. Security"], with specific reference to the situations in Indonesia, the Middle East, and France.
- b. Noted the President's request that the Director of Central Intelligence include in his oral briefing at the next Council meeting a short discussion of the topography of Sumatra.

The above action, as approved by the President on March 21, 1958, is transmitted herewith for appropriate implementation of paragraph b thereof.
