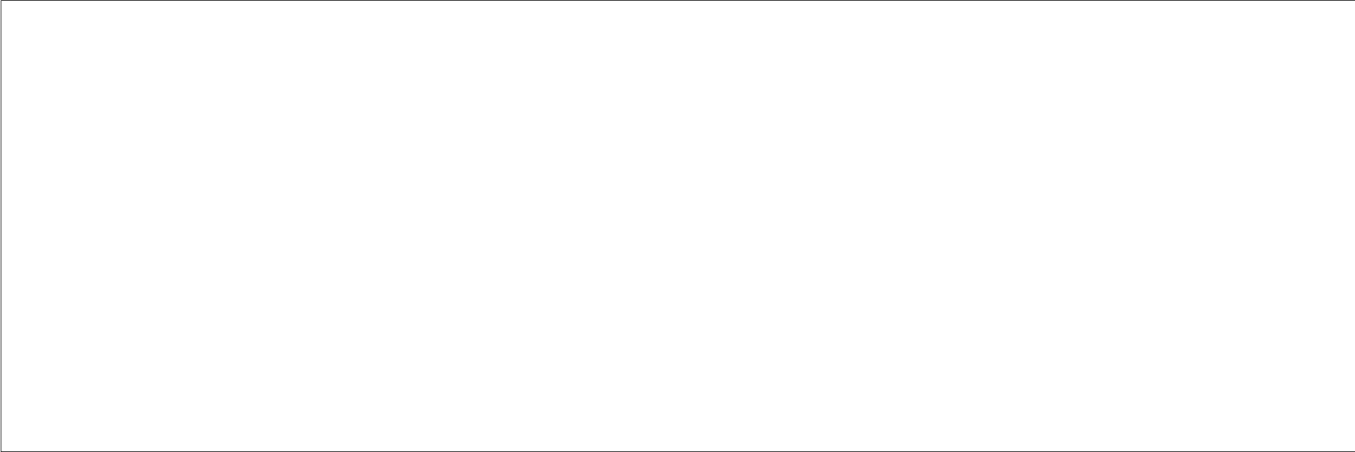

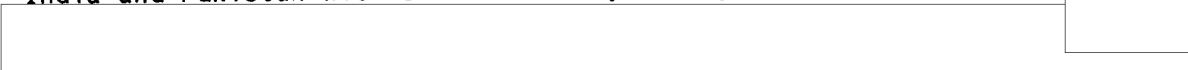
Assistant NIO/Africa [redacted] attended an NSC-chaired IG on the NSDD: Food for Progress.
