25X1 ° The Chief, PSD met with a local representative of Westinghouse Electric Corp. to discuss their efforts in developing an automated explosive detection system. This effort by Westinghouse was initiated in 1974 and has been funded by FAA as well as Westinghouse. The system is being examined as possibly applicable to the Headquarters Building package screening program. [Redacted]

° Following a report of possible impersonation of an Agency employee, The Security Duty Office received a call from a U.S. Customs Service Official, Atlanta office, who requested verification of former Agency affiliation of a suspect that the Customs Service was preparing to prosecute for drug smuggling. The suspect was claiming "ex agent" status with Agency and the Customs Service was attempting to resolve that issue before taking the case to court. The inquiry was referred to SSD/OSB for action. Subsequently, an Agency record check revealed the suspect had no affiliation with the Agency and the U.S. Customs Service was so advised. [redacted]

° The Security Duty Office also has two officers attending the Security Officers Training Program and one in basic VM computer training. [redacted]
