SUBJECT: Revision of DCID 1/14

1. It is recognized that the recommendations from the Investigative Standards Working Group for revision of DCID 1/14 constitute an optimum proposal from the security enhancement and cost effectiveness perspectives (SECOM-D-137). For various reasons, however, some members are reluctant to advocate across-the-board adoption of the Working Group's proposal as it is now written.

2. In the interest of reaching consensus within the Security Committee, I therefore offer the following modifications for members' consideration at the 17 June SECOM meeting:

- a. Reduce the scope of polygraph testing by eliminating subparagraphs 3k and 3l in the proposed Annex C.
- b. Exempt cabinet and sub-cabinet level Presidential appointees from polygraph examination requirements as permitted by the provisions of paragraph 2 currently in DCID 1/14.
- c. Change the Working Group's proposal for paragraph 5b(1) per the attached new page 2 of the draft.

3. Modifications accepted by the Security Committee would be referred to the Investigative Standards Working Group with instructions to incorporate them into the final draft of the revised DCID 1/14.
