- This memorandum is in lieu of minutes of the 10 and 17 June meetings of the Security Committee which were devoted primarily to consideration of the report of the Investigative Standards Working Group on revision of DCID 1/14 (U)
- The Working Group's principal recommendation dealt with use of the polygraph as a condition precedent to granting SCI access. Security Committee discussions failed to develop a consensus for that recommendation. In the absence of such a consensus it was agreed that:
