2.  presented a briefing and responded to questions concerning the DNSIX implementation plans and the DODISS security architecture. After considerable discussion, it appeared that a consensus was reached that the security information required for COINS purposes might well be passed by DNSIX to the gateway by means of information to be included in the session management messages which are being proposed to establish and terminate interactive sessions in DNSIX. Since the precise format and content of these messages have not yet been specified or implemented, the participants were in agreement that the desired information transfer could probably be accommodated in this way. It was agreed that  on behalf of the COINS PMO, would study this proposal and prepare a concept paper on the subject for further consideration by the group at the next meeting.
