

Dear Mr. Chairman:

The FY 1985 Intelligence Authorization Act reduced Office Automation Initiatives within the CCP by \$5 million. The reason for the reduction was based on the assessment that NSA had not selected an agency-standard workstation and the concern that the (TEMPEST-qualified) workstations were for Buildings 2A and 2B despite the buildings' TEMPEST protection." Since that time, NSA has selected an agency-standard workstation which is TEMPEST-qualified and cheaper than the GSA schedule unit price for the non-TEMPEST version of the same workstation. NSA believes that it is now more economical to procure exclusively TEMPEST-qualified workstations inasmuch as they will be installed (and rotated due to maintenance) into both shielded and nonshielded buildings.

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The purpose of this letter is to advise you that NSA plans to use the remaining \$4 million in FY 1985 CCP procurement funds, appropriated for this project, to purchase the standard workstation (see enclosure). The near-term acquisition of these workstations (and associated Alliance computer peripherals) is especially important as Operations Building 2A is scheduled for initial occupancy later this year. Additionally, NSA would like to begin modifying its existing facilities to accept the standard workstation components as these become available for installation. Finally, NSA seeks the Committee's approval to reprogram \$1 million of O&M funds within the FY 1985 CCP to arrange a 24-month lease purchase agreement with the vendor (Bang Laboratories Inc.) to obtain the Alliance computer facilities needed to provide an integrated office system.

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As sources for the reprogramming, NSA plans to use \$1 million of available
DM funds from within various equipment rental and maintenance accounts.
These funds are available without adverse impact due to slippages in several
equipment rental actions. On behalf of the Director of Central Intelligence,
I request your approval of this reprogramming action as a matter of
Congressional interest, and am prepared to provide additional information as
required.
