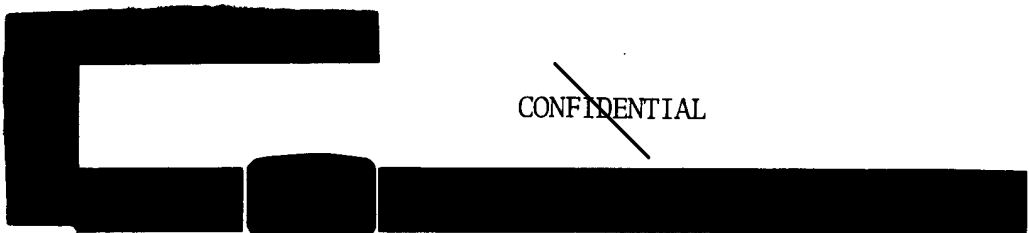

- DASD/ISA Amb. Robert Pelletrau

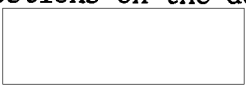

Mr. Currie has been on leave, and no one seems to know who will attend, but I would expect it to be the NIO (Mr. Vickers), someone from State (probably Elliott Abrams' shop), and a representative from ASD/ISA. Steve Ockenden told me the focus will be on Mexico, and my guess is that it will be a session very similar to the one they had on the Philippines (i.e., current status, U.S. aid posture, Sen Bradley may come with questions on the debt issue, etc.)
