PROGRAM II

1. Same as Program I except that it will be explained to the Hoover Commission Group that they will be given a broad overall coverage of the Clandestine Services with the details being left to the Special Study Group.

2. A general description of the functions of the CS, their historical and legal origin and some of the relationships with other government agencies (State and Defense) who provide policy guidance. Mr. Wisner

3. A description of the organizational arrangements within the Clandestine Services showing how compartmentation is preserved at all echelons and the points at which coordination and/or integration is accomplished. This would basically be a coverage of the organization chart of the CS with amplification on the internal working arrangements as necessary. Mr. Helms

4. A description of the planning and programming system for the Clandestine Services. This will be essentially the briefing [REDACTED] has given to the D. Group but adjusted to eliminate the more sensitive references and without the actual display - or at least without handling by the Group, of the documents involved. [REDACTED]
