## Ex-U. S. Envoy Flays Our Latin Policy

(UPI) - Former U.S. diplomat Ellis O. Briggs delivered a blistering attack on U.S. Latin American policy yesterday in a speech before the Inter American Press Association.

" Mr. Briggs, at various times Ambassador to Brazil, Uruguay, The Dominican republic, Peru, Spain, Greece, Republic of Korea and Nationalist China, called the Alliance for Progress "a Pandora's Box, with welfare state handles;" and said "stooges from the White House"

resident diplomats.

For Latin American political leaders - "whose first duty isto survive politically" - Mr. Briggs charged, the Alliance for Progress "threatened to create as many problems as it promised to solve.

"And if there is a more pernicious doctrine that compels the sponsor of an economic and representative of the U.S. social program to throw lighted. gasoline into his neighbor's woodshed, it has yet to come to the attention of history."
