Enclosed is my markup of your paper on leaks. Most of the changes are stylistic. The change in paragraph 3 deleting "lose good people and" stems from my view that this is an unnecessary exaggeration. The proposed deletion on page 2 related to the polygraph is important. The committee would be free in any event to use all appropriate investigative methods. Highlighting the polygraph might cause opponents to regard this initiative as a vehicle to obtain the polygraph's expanded use.
