This Reference Aid lists international conferences, solidarity days, diplomatic, and other events of known or potential significance for Soviet Bloc and Soviet clients' active measures and propaganda campaigns.

25X1

Active measures are designed to shape opinion in foreign countries on key political issues. As with propaganda, these activities are targeted at opinionmakers—such as political leaders, the media, and influential businessmen—as well as the public at large. They embrace a range of activity that includes:

- Placing disinformation in the foreign press.
- Surfacing forged documents.
- Spreading rumors through word of mouth.
- Promoting causes through local Communist parties or front groups.
- Shaping policy through agents of influence.

The following types of events are included in this Reference Aid:

- Conferences and meetings sponsored by Soviet international front groups.¹
- Events involving significant front group representation.
- Conferences and meetings sponsored by organizations targeted for Soviet Bloc active measures or propaganda operations.

¹ International Soviet front groups receive clandestine Soviet support and guidance for their activities. The International Department of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union provides direction to the various fronts through Soviet officials who are full-time members of the front secretariats or vice presidents of the organizations. Front rhetoric supports or promotes Soviet propaganda themes. The Soviets use the fronts to approach or co-opt individuals or organizations that would not be willing to associate with a group specifically identified as being connected with the Soviet Government. For the purpose of this Reference Aid, the 17 organizations that define themselves as "closely coordinating" international nongovernmental organizations are classified as front groups. This group includes the World Peace Council (WPC), the World Federation of Trade Unions (WFTU), the Women's International Democratic Federation (WIDF), the World Federation of Democratic Youth (WFDY), the International Union of Students (IUS), the International Organization of Journalists (IOJ), the Christian Peace Conference (CPC), the World Federation of Teachers' Unions (FISE), the Afro-Asian Peoples' Solidarity Organization (AAPSO), the Organization of Solidarity of the Peoples of Africa, Asia, and Latin America (OSPAAAL), the International Institute of Peace (IIP), the Berlin Conference of European Catholics (BCEC), the International Radio and Television Organization (OIRT), the World Federation of Scientific Workers (WFSW), the Asian Buddhist Conference for Peace (ABCP), the International Federation of Resistance Movements (FIR), and the International Association of Democratic Lawyers (IADL).

- Selected events sponsored by international organizations, such as the United Nations and the Nonaligned Movement, that the Soviets and their allies historically have attempted to manipulate through active measures and propaganda.
- Key diplomatic events—for example, summits, arms control, or base negotiations—that are known or probable targets for Soviet Bloc activity.
- International Communist party meetings.
- International and national gatherings for Communist mass organizations dealing with women, youth, labor, and other such issues; for example, the Soviet Committee for the Defense of Peace, and the Libyan People's Bureau.
- Selected anniversaries and diplomatic visits that are known or probable targets for propaganda campaigns. [Redacted]



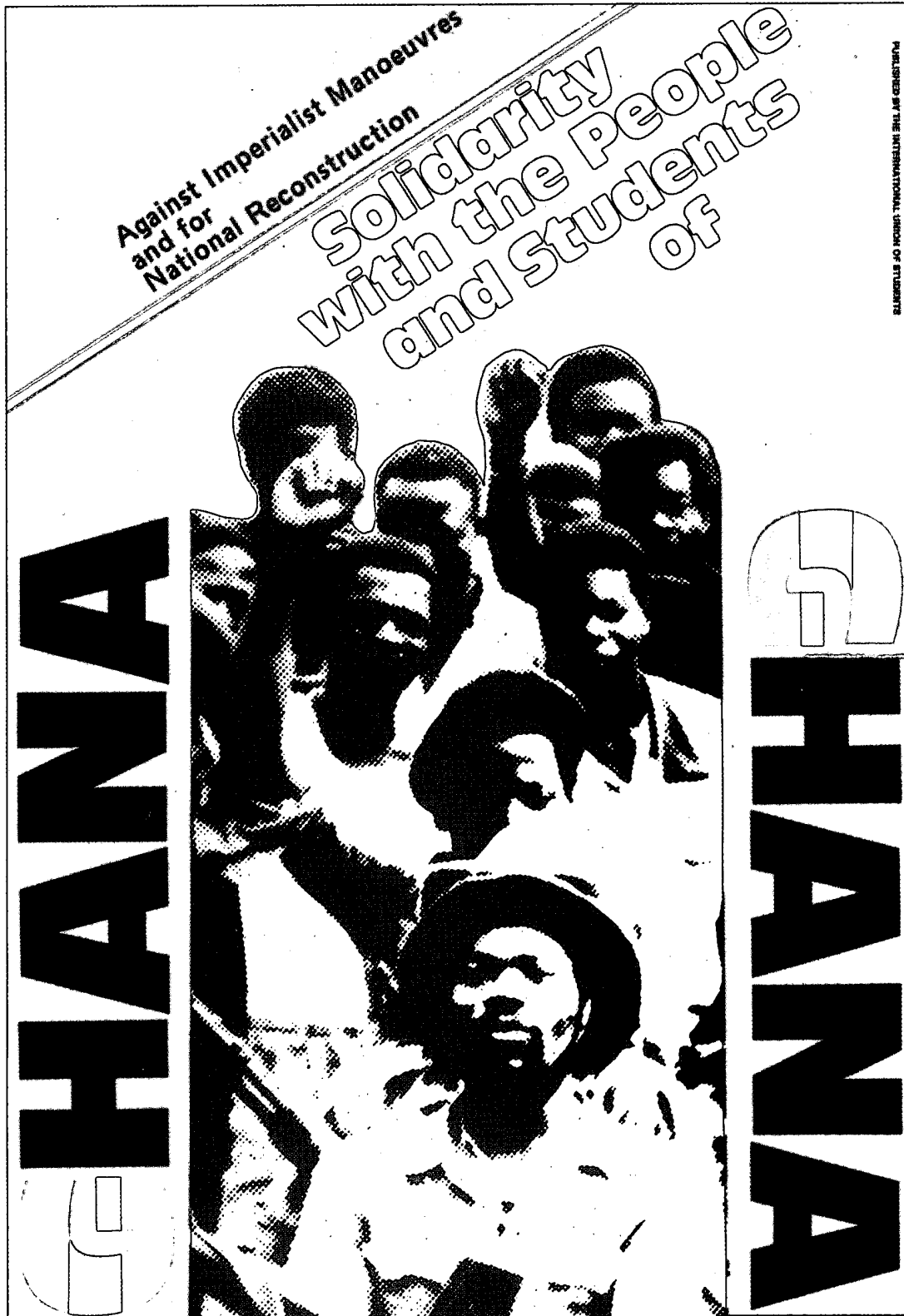

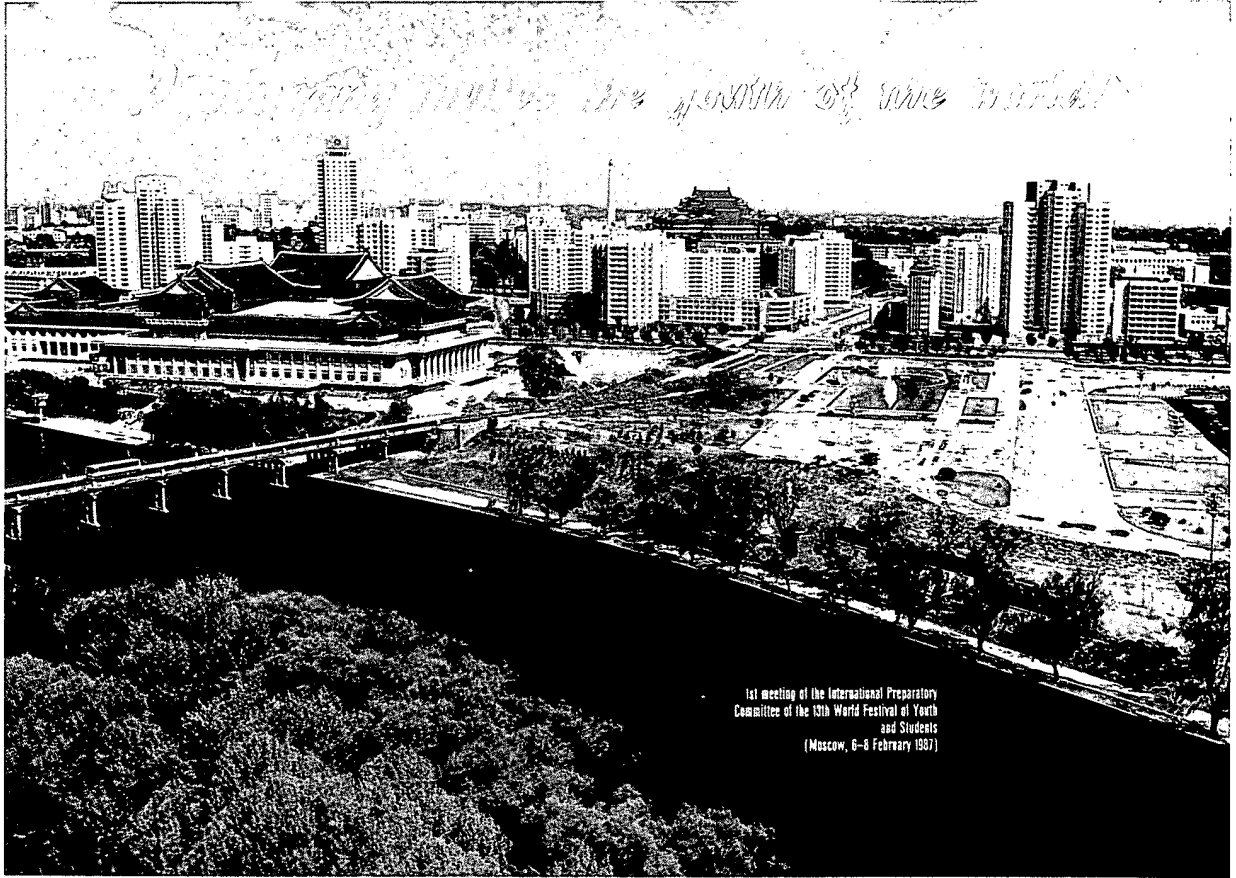
