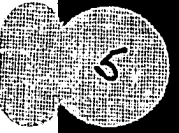

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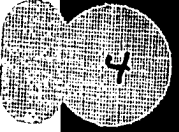
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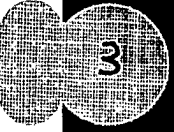
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Update on OL Activities

FY 87

Instead of giving an update on 4th Quarter activities, we'll be covering Fiscal Year '87, one of the most dynamic ever in the history of the Agency.....and one of the busiest for the Office of Logistics! Several major efforts were undertaken, and many logistical support records were broken.

Construction of the New Headquarters Building proceeded on schedule this year.

The majority of walls and floors are now in place. Wiring is under way, the entire exterior glass curtain wall was completed, and landscaping is in progress.

By the end of FY 87, about 25 percent of the space had been turned over to the Agency; as of now, the figure for space turned over is about 42 percent.

The Headquarters Visitor Control Centers at the entrances were completed.

The roads were repaved and restriped, and new curbing and lights were installed.

The Route 123/193 Roadway Improvements Project is now about 85 percent complete.

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
