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- a. Obligated the largest number of dollars by contract in the history of the Agency.
- b. FY-86 contract activity indicates that CIA ranks fourth of approximately sixty Federal departments and agencies in the amount of funds obligated by contract.
- c. Made significant improvement in reducing backlog of Agency contracts in settlement.
- d. Took steps to remedy certain vendor contract payment problems in a cooperative effort with the Office of Einance.
- e. Continued an initiative to provide a more structured approach in defining the Agency's procurement policies and procedures.
- f. Contracted with Coopers and Lybrand to complete a study of the Agency's procurement system. Final report dated 31 July 1986.
- g. Issued revised guidance to improve the presentation of cases before the Agency Contract Review Board. The Board reviews procurement actions exceeding \$500,000.
