(S/D) SIGNIFICANCE: CONTINUING PREPARATIONS FOR, OR SUPPORT OF, AN INCURSION INTO ANGOLA ARE OBSERVED IN THE ONDANGWA, OPÉRET, AND GROOTFONTEIN AREAS IN NAMIBIA (GRAPHIC 1 OF 2). 2. (S/D) REMARKS: THREE ADDITIONAL MIRAGE F-1, TWO MIRAGE III/V, AND ONE C-160 (NOT ON GRAPHIC) HAVE ARRIVED AT ONDANGWA WHEN ONLY FOUR MIRAGE F-1 WERE 25X1 PRESENT (GRAPHIC 2 OF 2). PREVIOUS SIGHTINGS OF MIRAGE AIRCRAFT AT THIS AIRFIELD HAVE COINCIDED WITH SOUTH AFRICAN MILITARY OPERATIONS INTO ANGOLA. OTHER AIR ORDER-OF-BATTLE INCLUDES SIX MB.326, SIX KUDU, THREE PUMA, AND FOUR ALOUETTE (NOT ON GRAPHIC). THE TWO MECHANIZED INFANTRY COMPANIES, PARKED IN A FIELD IMMEDIATELY EAST OF THE AIRFIELD 25X1 ARE NOT THESE UNITS PROBABLY HAVE DEPLOYED BACK TO OPERET OBSERVED. MILITARY CAMP 25X1 WHERE A SLIGHT INCREASE IN EQUIPMENT IS NOTED. TWO CANBERRA HAVE REDEPLOYED TO GROOTFONTEIN AIRFIELD THEY MAY HAVE BEEN THE 25X1 TWO SEEN IN FLIGHT NEAR ONDANGWA AIRFIELD 25X1 THESE AIRCRAFT PROBABLY WERE INVOLVED IN AIRSTRIKE MISSIONS. ONE PROBABLE BUCCANEER IS ON THE RUNWAY. BUCCANEER NORMALLY ARE NOT HERE. ONDANGWA AIRFIELD IS 36 NM SOUTH OF THE NAMIBIA-ANGOLA BORDER AND 155 NM NORTHWEST OF GROOTFONTEIN. OPERET MILITARY CAMP IS 50 NM SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF ONDANGWA. 25X1 3. COORDINATES 17-52-42S 015-57-00E
