Thank you for your letter of May 25 to Mr. J. S. Hodge regarding road improvements at the Central Intelligence Agency's entrance on Route 123.

The Department and the CIA are presently preparing an agreement to cover the CIA's funding of off-site road improvements at their entrance on Route 123. Once the agreement is executed, an engineering consultant will be employed to analyze traffic conditions and develop plans for the roadway improvements.
