Mr. Knoche:

George Murphy called in response to the Director's call to Senator Pastore's office this morning requesting that we be permitted to store some material with the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy. Senator Pastore discussed this matter with Mr. Murphy, and the latter's impression is that the answer would be in the affirmative, but the Senator asked that the request be put in writing. Mr. Murphy suggested that, in putting the request in writing, we not say that we understand this is all right with the Senator -- rather, to say something to the effect that we would very much appreciate if storage could be provided for certain highly sensitive material under the same arrangements that we had before, under the control of the Staff Director, and that it is the DCI's understanding that arrangements suitable to Pastore and Church would be made as to who would have access to the material; DCI could say he is asking this because of the extreme sensitivity of the information and we are aware of the very effective and tight controls exercised in keeping the previous sensitive information.

DCI asked if you would prepare letter.
