- 1. Mission 6002 was an operational AQUATONE Mission staged from EIELSON AFB Alaska with KAMCHATKA Peninsula as the target objective. The general flight path was from EIELSON across Saint Mathews Island and then west to within approximately 10 miles of OSTROV KARAGINSKIY. At this point the pilot aborted the mission because of weather and returned to EIELSON on the reverse course.
- 2. Mission 6002 servied a System I S-Band ELINT capability and a System III VHF COMINT capability with results as follows:
 - a. ELINT: The presence of U.S. radar signals upon leaving and reentering Alaska indicated proper equipment performance. <u>No Seriet radar signals were intercepted</u>. This fact is not unusual imagement as the current Radar Order of Battle carries no S-band radar in the area.
 - b. COMINT: The System III functioned very well as attested by clear English voice transmissions up until out of range of Alaska and again upon reentry. No foreign voice was intercepted.
