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RECOMMENDED CHANGES

- 1. Page i, CONTENTS, paragraph II, 1.a.(3), word should be "cleared" not "clearer."
- 2. Page 4, paragraph 3, line 6. Change to read: postulate the vulnerabilities of and threats to Intelligence.
- 3. Page 11, number 5, Emanations should be adjusted to right one space for alignment.
- 4. Page 12,(1), line 9, change: "is free" to read: "may be free."

Reason: There may be some system configurations which will not permit such unauthorized access. "IS" is too strong and definite.

- 5. Page 13, paragraph (2), last sentence. This statement is not entirely true as an individual with some type of clearance would be less of a threat than someone without any type of clearances. Change sentence to read:
- ...highest level in the system poses less risk than an uncleared user but nevertheless does present a risk.
