RECOMMENDED CHANGES

1. Page i, CONTENTS, paragraph II, 1.a.(3), word should be "cleared" not "clearer."
2. Page 4, paragraph 3, line 6. Change to read: postulate the vulnerabilities of and threats to Intelligence.
3. Page 11, number 5, Emanations should be adjusted to right one space for alignment.
4. Page 12,(1), line 9, change: "is free" to read: "may be free."

Reason: There may be some system configurations which will not permit such unauthorized access. "IS" is too strong and definite.

5. Page 13, paragraph (2), last sentence. This statement is not entirely true as an individual with some type of clearance would be less of a threat than someone without any type of clearances. Change sentence to read:

...highest level in the system poses less risk than an uncleared user but nevertheless does present a risk.
