2. The activities of the Office of Security (OS) during the week of 11 - 18 February 1987 were highlighted by the following items:

*a. On 11 February, an OS representative provided the D/OCA and his staff with a "dry run" of the Security Awareness Briefing prepared for new members of the SSCI and HPSCI. Subsequent discussions resulted in the D/OCA requesting that a similar briefing be provided to members of the new Congressional Select Committees investigating the Iran/Contra situation.
