Strengthening the Functions and Role SUBJECT: of the Office of the Inspector General

I have carefully reviewed the report of the Steering Group on strengthening the functions and role of the Office of the Inspector General forwarded with your memorandum of 1 December 1987. I congratulate the members of the Steering Group on an excellent report. Your oral report to the senior staff yesterday was warmly received.

- I approve the report as written. I intend to make copies of it available to the intelligence oversight committees I wish to start the implementation process immediately and ask that you continue to oversee the implementation of the Steering Group's report. This will require a number of administrative directions in order to make certain that the career path program is promptly put into place.
- In addition to the recommendations of the Steering Group, and after consultation with Deputy Director Gates, I would like to add the following to the process:
 - The Deputy Inspector General should be elevated from SIS-04 to SIS-05 to make the IG office parallel and comparable to the directorates.
 - We should initially limit the pool of fast-rising managers assigned to the IG to those from Category I GS-15s through SIS-03.
 - We should monitor the adequacy of the present Investigations and Compliance Staff and I am entirely receptive to augmenting resources in this area to assure a more aggressive use of this unit, especially by the DCI and DDCI.
 - The Inspector General should report directly to the DCI.,
 - I intend to include the Inspector General in the Monday morning senior management breakfast.
- Again, my sincere thanks to you and to the members of your Steering Group for a job well done.
