1. Yesterday [redacted] visited with our staff and outlined the history of his efforts to distribute a written survey and conduct oral interviews with senior officials of the outgoing Carter Administration in an effort to determine their degree of satisfaction with the intelligence provided by the Community during their tenure in office. [redacted]

2. We agreed that a similar kind of survey might appropriately be prepared for senior officials of the Reagan Administration. Our thinking is that such a survey should be distributed no earlier than during the officials' last six months in office and no later than three months after their departure. As was done in the case of the original survey, careful thought would need to be given to the kinds of information sought, the wording of the questions, and the level and scope of the sampling. 3. [redacted] has given us the names of several individuals who helped to develop the original survey and has offered to consult with us as we give this matter more thought. [redacted]
