MONTHLY NARRATIVE SUMMARY REPORT - DECEMBER 1982

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2. During the latter part of the month, we were provided a new Headquarter's Regulation, [] - Radiation Safety. The regulation requires each independent office to establish through their component safety officers, a listing of all radiation producing equipment under their cognizance and to report in writing to the Chief, Safety Staff, DDA within 60 days of the issuance of the regulation, identifying the exact location of all equipment and materials capable of producing either ionizing or nonionizing radiation, excluding cathode ray tubes, video display terminals, and television sets. Additionally, [] requires ^{reporting} in writing on a monthly basis, future acquisitions of such equipment or materials to the Chief, Safety Staff, after plans for such acquisitions have been approved.

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Agency wide, OC will bear the greatest reporting responsibilities and will make every reasonable attempt to provide the required information as soon as it can be collected. The Safety Officer will broker any OC reporting variance to this regulation with the Chief, Safety Staff as/if required.
