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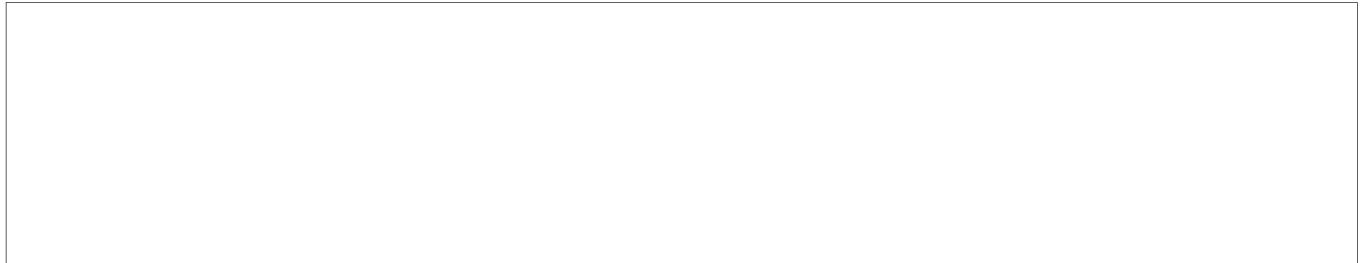

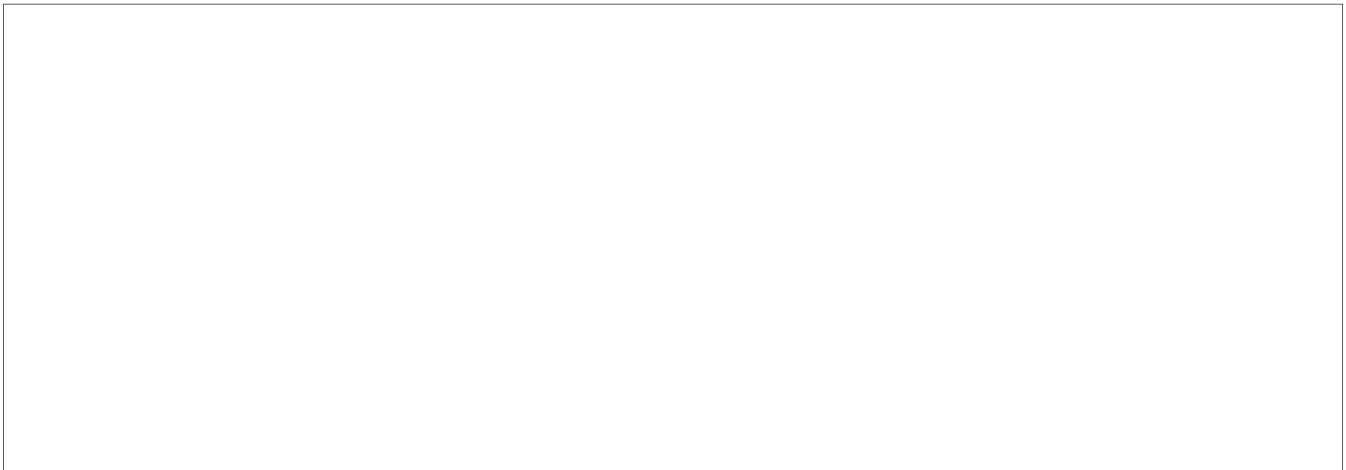
2. Responses to the corporate business areas of the OC Strategic Plan are being integrated into the OC-MPS Requirements Tracking System (RTS). The RTS will allow the Office to maintain a chronology and track the development of each business area.

3. Satellites:

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a.  participated in a special MILSATCOM Panel working session on 14-15 January at the MILSATCOM Office, Arlington Hall Station (AHS). The purpose of the session was to collect, analyze and prepare to present information relating to an EHF wideband package to the C<sup>3</sup> Review Council. A second working session is planned during the first week of February.

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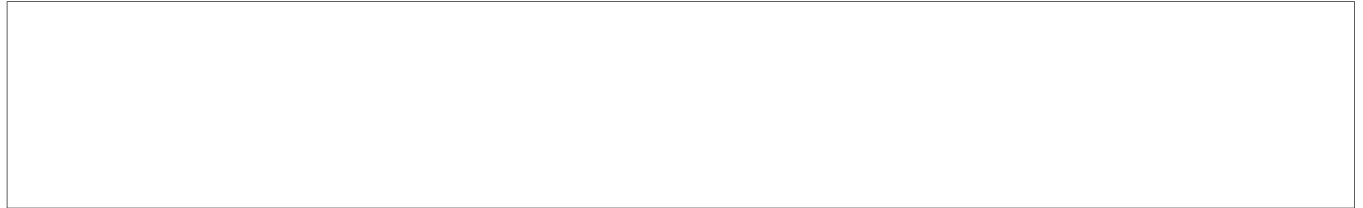

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OC-AMD

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1. [redacted] OTE careerist, reported in 21 January as Chief, Developmental Training Branch.

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2. [redacted] has been named to replace [redacted] as OC's Security Officer. The tentative date for his reporting is 10 February.

3. About 20 employees attended the Wang PC briefing on 17 January. The audience was comprised of personnel with a variety of interest and levels of experience in the use of the Wang PCs. As a follow-up to the briefing, the forming of an OC Wang PC Users Group was discussed and will be explored.

4. On 16 January, the D/CO accompanied Mr. Richard J. Kerr, Deputy Director for Administration, on a tour of the training facility and an introduction to the Department Chiefs.

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6. Four operations training instructors are conducting overseas training with six additional instructors processing for on-site training. There is presently a lull in training activities but projections for February and March indicate a significant increase in overseas training requirements may be expected.

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7. With completion of the second TDMA installation in [redacted] the Communications School instructor utilized the training session to determine minimum terminal downtime required

for TDMA training. Although the goal was a minimum of 24 hours, only eight hours downtime was required to conduct this training.

10. On 12 January, the second running of Project SCREEN testing was held at the Ramada Inn with nine TCO applicants taking the profile testing.

11. OC-AMD/RES personnel telephoned more than 600 individuals who had received Personal History Statement (PHS) packets from OC in response to reviews of their resumes or from recruitment presentations to request they return the completed PHS packets as soon as possible. An interesting note evolved from this endeavor. Of 102 applicants who stated they no longer had an interest in employment with the Agency, 36 indicated their lack of interest was due to the increase in terrorism throughout the world. Although several other reasons, such as continuing education or additional job opportunities, were also cited, the requirement to serve overseas and the associated risk from terrorism was the major reason given for cancelling many employment applications.

12. All biographic profiles produced by OP for OC have now been placed in the soft files.

13. Agency records retention schedules have been modified to allow us to keep soft files on retirees for up to 18 months.

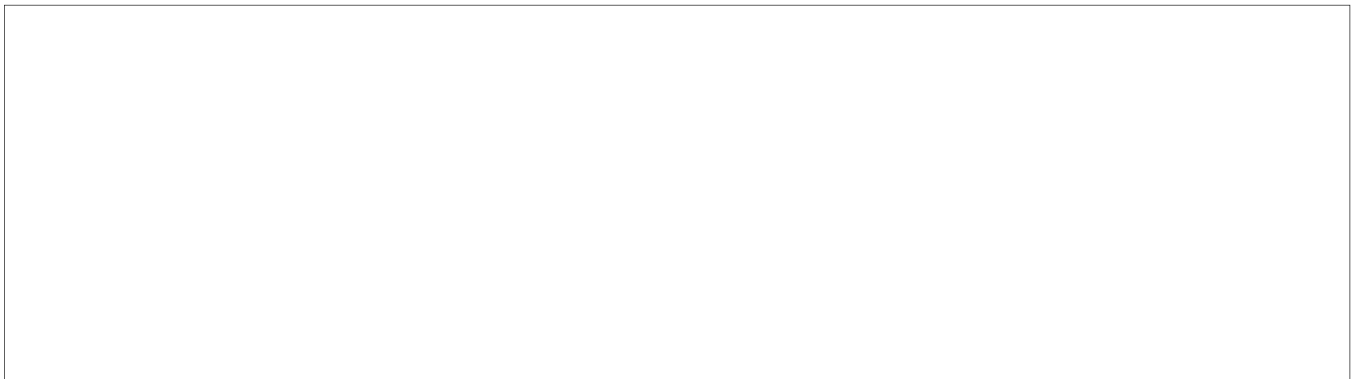
This will be particularly useful when annuitants are processed for independent contracts. Because soft files cannot be stored at the Records Center, it will be necessary to send all original material to OP for inclusion in an employee's Official Personnel File and destroy the remainder. Retention beyond 18 months would be difficult even if the schedules allowed more flexibility. The new motorized OC filing system requires careful monitoring for balance. Before the recent purge of retiree files, the machinery was beginning to experience considerable stress due to load imbalance. Reduction of the files on retirees and resignees has corrected the problem.

14. OC Officers attended the Upward Mobility Program, DA Career Day, which was held at Headquarters on 16 January. OC advertised three Upward Mobility vacancy notices: [redacted] (OC-AMD) represented the TCO position. [redacted] (OC-AMD) represented the ET position and [redacted] (OC-ED) represented the ADP Librarian position. Several employees were interviewed in connection with the vacant positions. The DA was well represented and a special "thanks" is extended to the three participants who represented OC.

1. The DDA and the D/CO toured the Cryptographic Materiels Branch (CMB) on 16 January.

2. CMB personnel received a well-earned certificate of appreciation and cash awards on 17 December. The awards were in recognition of sustained high performances during the period 1984-1985.

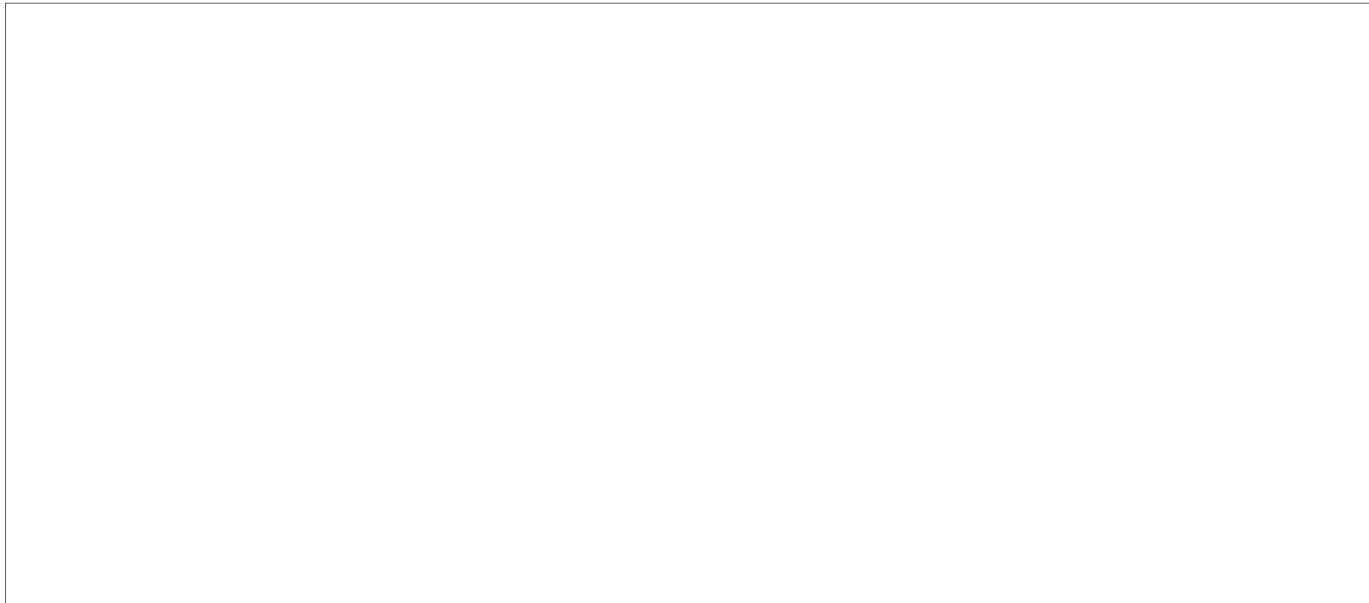

A total of 60 circuits [redacted] and 30 circuits at OIT have been identified as most representative of the circuitry handled by the message switches.

c. CONTEL presented an updated draft of the results of a network simulation model to determine potential problems in the MERCURY architecture. The results show that projected volumes can be handled for the four-node CONUS network which will be fielded from 1986 through 1988. Additional refinements of the model data will occur and expansion to simulate remote deployment of MERCURY systems is planned.

2. Second Phase Automated Relay Switch (SPARS):

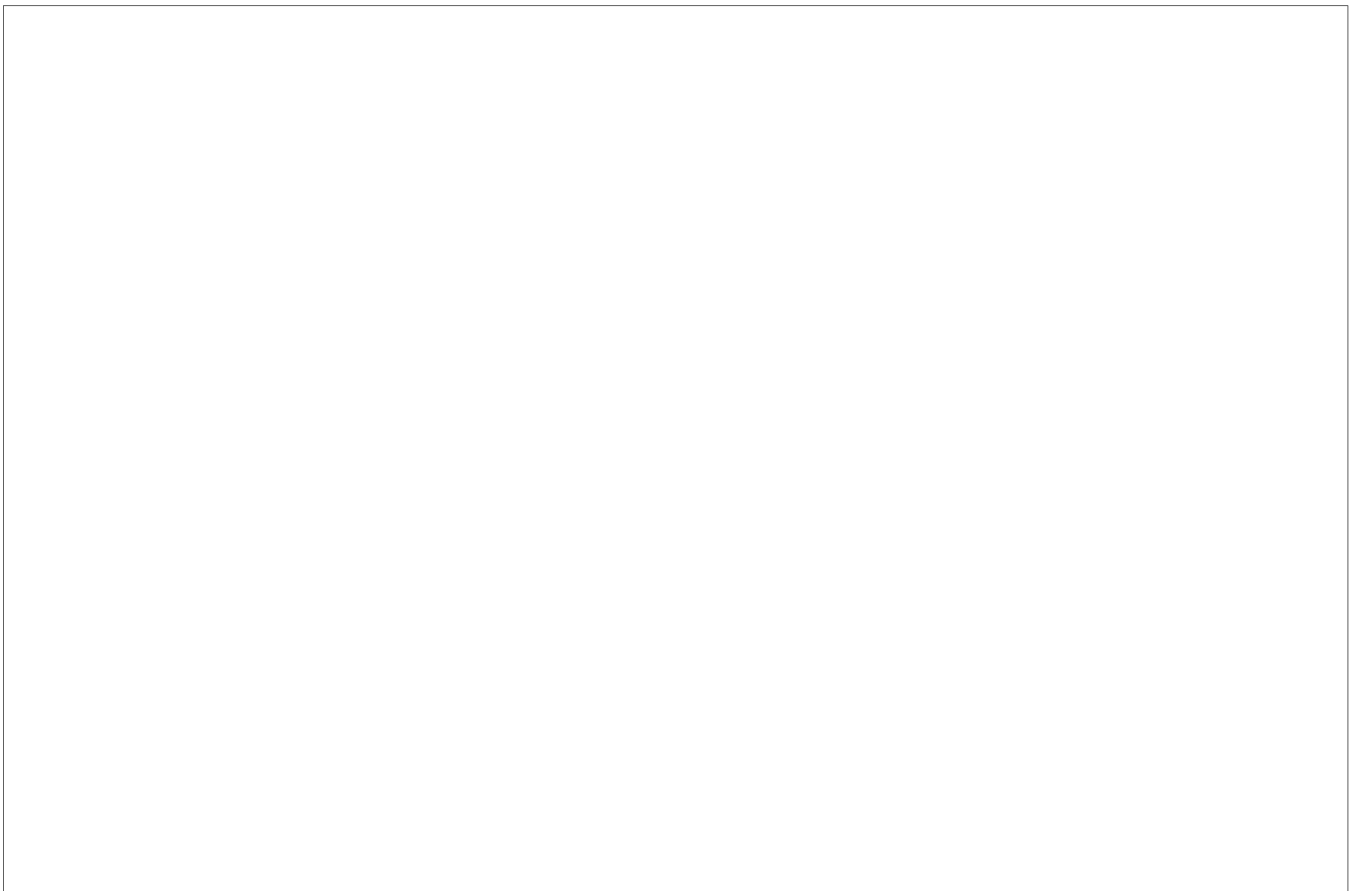

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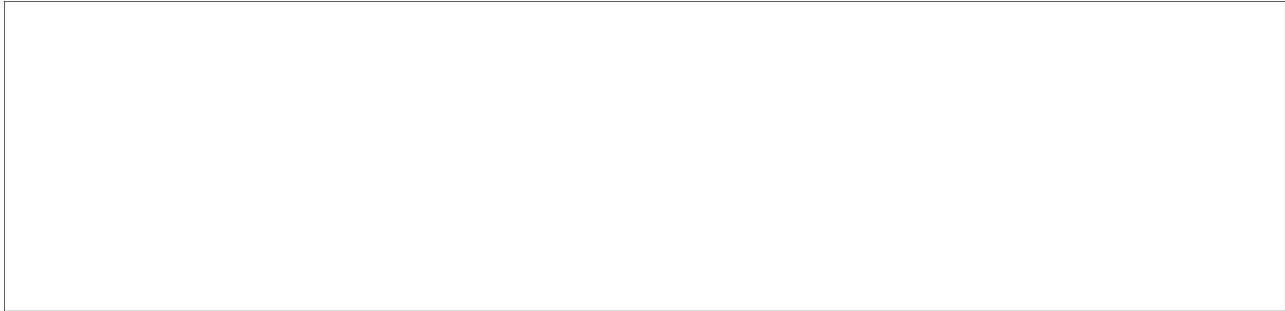

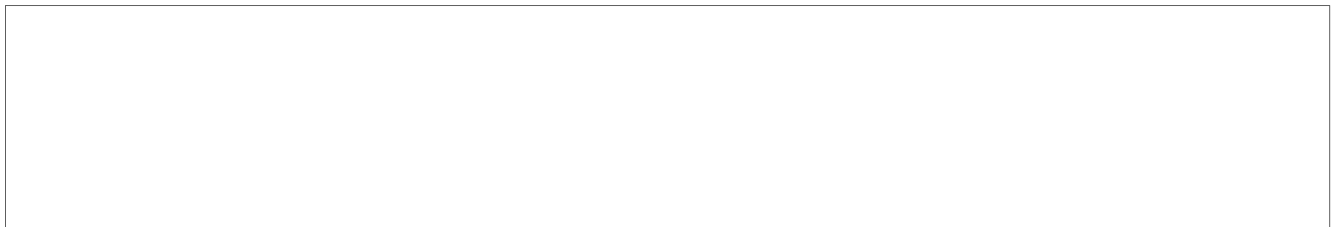
