A judge Tuesday ordered an accused drug smuggler who claimed he was a CIA agent to disclose whether the Classified Information Act would be used as his defense. Authorities believe Joseph Diego "Casey" Ramirez, 37, used money he got smuggling cocaine from Latin America to shower the city of Princeton, Minn., with gifts, including police cars. U.S. Attorney Thor Anderson sought the information as "a precautionary move" since Ramirez allegedly told others he was a CIA agent.
