25X1 [redacted] office of the IG, dropped by to discuss our last legis-  
lative proposals as they related to Section 6(f) of P. L. 110 as added by P. L. 53,  
the provision relating to the employment of retired officers. [redacted] 25X1  
is interested in determining how the Agency reached the figure of 35 officers in  
our last proposal. He also raised several questions for resolution at a future  
date; such as what effect the utilization of retired officers in contract categories  
would have on the number, and also the distinctions between categories of  
retired officers. Some background information was given to [redacted] 25X1  
including a copy of the justifications used in our 1957 proposals.

25X1 Talked with [redacted] Security Officer (OTR) regarding the proposed  
approach to Senator Humphrey and Congresswoman Bolton, requesting that  
they lecture in the OTR lecture series this summer. [redacted] 25X1  
indicated that OTR would coordinate their approach to these members of Congress with the Legis-  
lative Counsel.
