You know, powerful anti-intelligence groups like the American Civil Liberties Union and Americans for Democratic Action won't like my Petition.

But, we've got to beat them.

Because America's security is weaker than I've ever seen it. And this threatens the survival of you, me and every other American.

Remember, our national survival depends on national security.

For example, <u>Newsweek</u> magazine says the halls of Congress are a "prime target" for Russian spies. Or, maybe you saw the <u>Time</u> magazine story on Communist spies working in the halls of Congress.

But now liberal Senators like Ted Rennedy want all of our
