1. Gore Trip to Moscow

On 4 December Senator-elect Albert Gore, Jr. (D., TN) was given a pre-trip arms control briefing by [redacted] A/ACIS. Larry Gershwin, NIO/SP, and [redacted] DDI/SOVA, briefed on Soviet weapons systems and leadership issues. Gore's self-initiated trip to Moscow under HPSCI auspices takes place from 4 - 10 December. On 5 December, Congressman Mark Siljander (R., MI) was given a pre-trip political and security briefing on Romania.

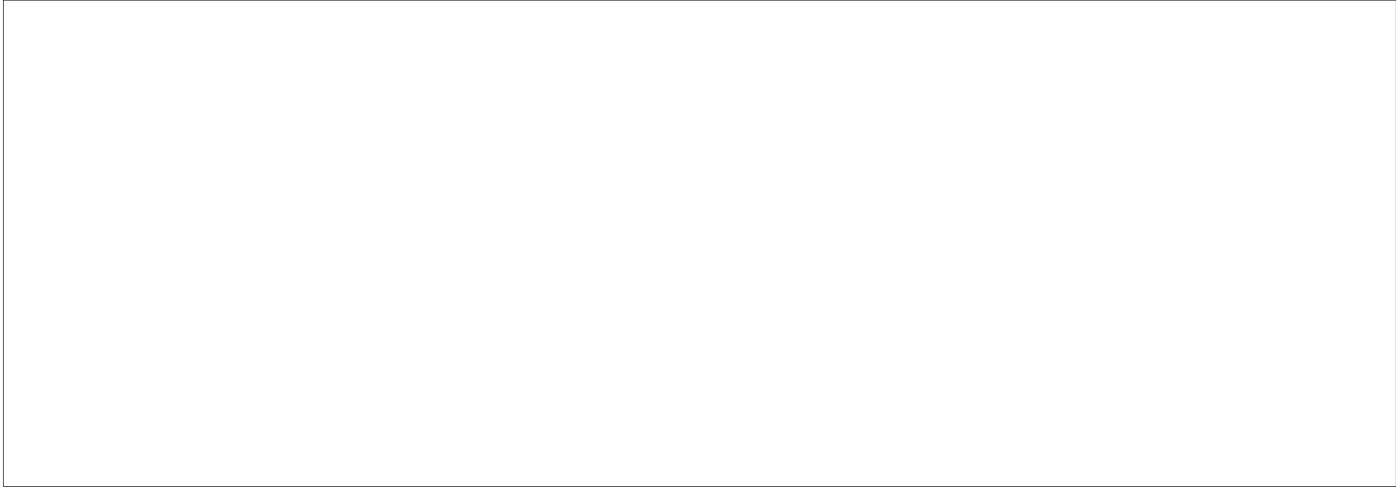
