FOREIGN ASSISTANCE/CENTRAL AMERICA MEETING  
PS 117-24 (Friday, August 3, 1984)1. Jackson Plan Authorization in the Senate

No final decision has been reached, but the option of a truncated House Foreign Aid Bill continues to seem more attractive than amending the Omnibus Supplemental. A decision could come on short notice early next week. Task Force members should be prepared to move quickly.

2. FY-84 Omnibus Supplemental in the Senate

This remain our highest priority. We are concerned about possible amendments by Sasser (RMTG) and Inouye (reduction in MAP for El Salvador). General Gast recommended that a State/DSAA team call on appropriate Senators to explain the RMTG situation before a floor vote. Secretary Shultz is being asked to call Inouye on El Salvador. The President's letter to Baker/Byrd is being cleared in the White House. Floor books will be ready for distribution by late Monday.

Calls to 40 key Senators have been assigned and should begin on August 6 and be completed by August 7. Reports should be sent promptly to State/H. Conference could take place next week. We should be prepared to cope with a Conference Report moving to the House floor, where a major battle is likely.

3. FY-85 Appropriations Bill in the House

Markup will continue on August 7. Long is expected to offer an amendment holding back \$5 million or more in military assistance for El Salvador until the AIFLD murders are prosecuted. McHugh intends to introduce an amendment calling for aid to El Salvador in two tranches. Edwards reportedly has softening language prepared if McHugh is successful.
