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Conclusion of July 30 IG Working Group Meeting
on Foreign Assistance/Central America

1. FY-84 Omnibus Supplemental in the House.

Chairman Whitten reportedly has decided to take the Omnibus Supplemental to the floor Wednesday afternoon without a rule thereby making the proposed Kemp amendment "out of order". It was decided that, given this situation, Kemp should introduce a different amendment in an effort to obtain whatever we can, i.e. \$43.2 in additional MAP which has been authorized but not appropriated for FY 84 plus \$50 million.

The telephone campaign to reach 148 key swing Members will continue using revised talking points; it must be completed by COB July 31. The search for a respectable Democratic co-sponsor continues without much prospect for success.

2. FY-84 Omnibus Supplemental in the Senate.

Markup of the Omnibus Supplemental by the Senate Appropriations Committee may well take place on Thursday afternoon. Representatives of T and DSAA will brief Senator Inouye, a possible critic on Central America, on Wednesday at 5:00 p.m. A briefing for SAC Members and senior staff will be offered for Wednesday.

3. Foreign Assistance Authorization Bill in the Senate.

The Foreign Aid Bill might come up in the Senate as early as Friday. Efforts to line up co-sponsors for the Mathias Amendment continue. A NSC-State-DOD briefing on Turkey for selected Senators will take place on Thursday at 2:00 p.m.

4. FY-85 Appropriations Bill in the House.

The Bill is expected to be marked up by the Foreign Ops Subcommittee on Wednesday, August 1 at 9:30 am. We expect a number of amendments, including unhelpful ones on Jordan and the Philippines.

5. Other Business.

- A Task Force Meeting will take place at 10:00 a.m. in the Operations Center Conference Room to discuss, inter alia, the Intelligence Authorization Bill.

- T/DSAA briefings of the Boren-Johnston Senate groups are tentatively scheduled for Wednesday.

- The idea of a press backgrounder will be kept under active consideration.

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
