SUBJECT: CODEL JOHNSTON: CALL ON ARMED FORCES COMMANDER

- 1. CONFIDENTIAL ENTIRE TEXT
- 2. SUMMARY: IN REMARKS TO CODEL JOHNSTON, NEW HONDURAN CINC EXPRESSED VIEWS ON REGIONAL SITUATION VERY SIMILAR TO THOSE OF HIS PREDECESSOR, GENERAL ALVAREZ, AND ALSO IN HARMONY WITH THOSE OF PRESIDENT SUAZO. LOPEZ SEES NICARAGUA AS PRINCIPAL REGIONAL THREAT; FAVORS INCREASED SUPPORT TO ANTI-SANDINISTAS; AS WELL AS CLOSE MILITARY COOPERATION WITH EL SALVADOR. ONLY NEW WRINKLE APPEARS TO BE LOPEZ' DESIRE TO TAKE ANOTHER LOOK AT GOH/FDN RELATIONSHIP AND POSSIBILITIES FOR INCREASED FDN/ARDE COLLABORATION. LOPEZ HAS RECEIVED FEELERS FROM EDEN PASTORA. END SUMMARY.
- 3. SENATORS J. BENNETT JOHNSTON (D-LA) AND LAWTON CHILES (D-FLA) CALLED ON ARMED FORCES COMMANDER GEN. WALTER LOPEZ REYES MORNING OF 18 APRIL. ACCOMPANYING THE SENATORS WERE STAFFERS RICHARD COLLINS, DOUGLAS OLIN AND LTC. RAY BRUCKNER. AMBASSADOR, PAO, AND LABATT WERE ALSO PRESENT. THE CONVERSATION WAS IN ENGLISH. FOLLOWING ARE SALIENT POINTS OF GEN. LOPEZ' REPLIES TO THE SENATORS' QUESTIONS:
- 4. ON US POLICY TOWARDS CENTRAL AMERICA:

THE US SHOULD NOT CUT ASSISTANCE TO THE REGION BUT SHOULD INCREASE IT. CUBA IS GOING TO MAKE ITS MOVE THIS YEAR. THE SANDINISTAS ARE GROWING WEAKER AND THAT WORRIES CASTRO. CASTRO IS CONVINCED THAT THE US IS GOING TO INCREASE ITS PRESSURE AGAINST NICARAGUA OVER COMING MONTHS AND HE MAY WANT TO SEND COMBAT TROOPS OR, AT LEAST, MOVE MILITARY ADVISORS TO BOLSTER THE

SANDINISTAS IN POWER. IT IS ALSO POSSIBLE THAT CASTRO MAY SEND INFILTRATORS INTO HONDURAS TO EASE THE PRESSURE ON NICARAGUA.

5. ON USG AID TO ANTI-SANDINISTA GUERRILLAS:

THE ANTI-SANDINISTAS MUST BE RE-ORGANIZED IF THEY ARE TO BE SUCCESSFUL AGAINST THE SANDINISTAS. THEY MUST FIGHT UNDER A UNIFIED COMMAND. RIGHT NOW EACH OF THE REBEL GROUPS IS FIGHTING ITS OWN WAR. NEVERTHELESS, THEY HAVE SUPPORT WITHIN NICARAGUA. THEY COULD TOPPLE THE SANDINISTA REGIME IF THEY COULD CARRY OUT STRONG, CONCERTED ACTIONS AGAINST IT. THEY ALSO NEED TO MAKE BETTER USE OF AVAILABLE EQUIPMENT. IF THE USG AND THE GOH GAVE THE ANTI-SANDINISTAS MORE ASSISTANCE, THE SANDINISTAS COULD BE OUSTED BEFORE THE US PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS THIS YEAR.

6. PROBLEMS WITH THE ANTI-SANDINISTAS:

THE REBELS LACK A WELL ESTABLISHED GUERRILLA INFRASTRUCTURE INSIDE NICARAGUA. THEY LACK SAFEHOUSES IN
WHICH TO STORE MATERIEL. THEY RELY HEAVILY ON AIR
DROPS AND MULE TRAINS FOR RE-SUPPLY. THEY ARE NOT
EQUIPPED TO FIGHT GUERRILLA-STYLE WAR; THEY ARE FORCED
TO USE HIT-AND-RUN TACTICS. NICARAGUA IS NOT EL
SALVADOR. NICARAGUA IS A BIGGER COUNTRY. IT IS
DIFFICULT FOR THE ANTI-SANDINISTAS TO MAINTAIN AN
ADEQUATE LOGISTICS BASE. THEY COULD HAVE MORE SERIOUS
PROBLEMS WHEN THE SANDINISTAS RECEIVE THE L-39S THEY
JUST BOUGHT. THESE PLANES CAN PROVIDE CLOSE AIR
SUPPORT TO AN ANTI-GUERRILLA EFFORT.

7. ON PROBLEMS ANTI-SANDINISTAS CAUSE IF USG AID IS CUT:

GOH IS CONCERNED THAT REBELS COULD BECOME A ROGUE ARMY INSIDE HONDURAS IF USG ENDS ITS SUPPORT FOR THE ANTISANDINISTA ACTIVITIES. THIRTY TO FORTY PERCENT OF THE ANTI-SANDINISTAS FORCES IN HONDURAS CAME HERE AS REFUGEES SOON AFTER SOMOZA'S OUSTER. (EMBASSY COMMENT: THIS IS AN EXAGGERATED FIGURE). REMAINDER HAVE COME IN SINCE TO JOIN THE GUERRILLAS. ALMOST FROM THE BEGINNING, NICARAGUAN EXILES IN COUNTRYSIDE CAUSED CRIME WAVE -- E.G. -- KIDNAPPINGS FOR RANSOM, BANK ROBBERIES, ETC. IF GUERRILLAS ARE DISBANDED, MEMBERS COULD TURN AGAIN TO CRIME WITHIN HONDURAS.

8. ON NICARAGUAN MILITARY STRENGTH

SUBJECT: CODEL JOHNSTON: CALL ON ARMED FORCES COMMANDER

NICARAGUA IS BUILDING A NEW EXTRA-LONG RUNWAY TO ACCOMMODATE TWO OR THREE FIGHTER SQUADRONS. THEY HAVE PILOTS TRAINING IN CUBA AND EUROPE ON MIG-21S. THE CUBANS ALSO HAVE MIG-21S READY FOR THE SANDINISTAS BUT HAVE NOT DELIVERED THEM FOR FEAR OF USG RESPONSE. THE USG AND THE GOH SHOULD NOT LET THE CUBANS DELIVER THESE AIRCRAFT TO NICARAGUA. US SHOULD TRAIN MORE HONDURAN PILOTS BUT COST TO HONDURAS IS TOO HIGH. HONDURAS WILL NEED AT LEAST THREE MORE YEARS TO HAVE SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF TRAINED PILOTS; PRESENTLY IT ONLY HAS 28 JET QUALIFIED PILOTS. AN EXCHANGE PROGRAM WITH THE US COULD HELP TRAIN MORE HONDURAN PILOTS. NICARAGUA IS ALSO PRE-POSITIONING MATERIEL NEAR HONDURAN BORDER. HONDURAS IS WORKING ON

ANTI-TANK DEFENSES TO COUNTER NICARAGUA'S TANK THREAT. HONDURAS NEEDS ARMAMENTS LIKE SNAKE EYE BOMB IT IS PURCHASING FROM US (FMS CASE) TO FIGHT NICARAGUAN TANKS.

9. ON REPRESSION INSIDE NICARAGUA:

THE SCHEDULED ELECTIONS WILL BE A SHAM. SANDINISTAS ARE ALLOWING 16-YEAR OLDS TO VOTE BECAUSE THEY HAVE BEEN BRAINWASHED. SANDINISTA REGIME HAS FILLED THE COUNTRY'S JAILS WITH OPPONENTS. MAJORITY OF NICARAGUANS ARE AGAINST SANDINISTAS AND ARE LOOKING FOR AN ALTERNATIVE TO THEIR RULE.

10. ON USG AND GOH ASSISTANCE TO EL SALVADOR:

GEN. LOPEZ WAS IN FAVOR OF US TRANSFER OF HELICOPTERS TO EL SALVADOR. THEY ARE EXCELLENT FOR COUNTER-INSUR-GENCY WORK; WILL HELP GOES MOVE ITS BATTALIONS WHERE NEEDED FASTER. HONDURAS TOO PLANS TO CONTINUE HELPING GOES WITH TRAINING AT THE REGIONAL MILITARY TRAINING CENTER (RMTC) IN TRUJILLO. GEN. LOPEZ IS WELL DISPOSED TOWARD IDEA OF ALLOWING TWO GOES BATTALIONS TO MOVE 10 KMS INSIDE HONDURAN TERRITORY TO ACT AS BLOCKING FORCE AGAINST GUERRILLAS IN UPCOMING OPERATIONS BUT DUE TO POLITICAL SENSITIVITY OF ISSUE, GEN. LOPEZ WOULD LIKE TO OBTAIN PRESIDENT SUAZO'S APPROVAL BEFORE PERMITTING GOES TROOPS TO ENTER HONDURAS.

11. ON MOVING THE RMTC:

THE HONDURAN ARMED FORCES ARE THINKING OF RELOCATING RMTC ELSEWHERE TO SOLVE RAMIREZ CASE. GEN. LOPEZ WILL BE CONSULTING HONDURAN RMTC COMMANDER SOON ABOUT POSSIBLE NEW SITE. HE WILL COORDINATE SITE SELECTION WITH US FORCES

12. ON USG-BUILT AIRFIELDS:

GEN. LOPEZ PRAISED THE QUALITY OF PALMEROLA AND LA CEIBA AIRFIELDS. THE HONDURAN AIR FORCE IS THINKING OF RELOCATING MOST OF ITS AIRCRAFT TO PALMEROLA FIELD WHERE THEY WILL BE SAFER. THE AIR FORCE IS ALSO THINKING OF MOVING ITS PILOT TRAINING CENTER FROM PALMEROLA TO LA CEIBA FOR SAFETY REASONS (LA CEIBA IS AT SEA LEVEL).

13. COMMENT: MOST SIGNIFICANT INSIGHT INTO LOPEZ' THINKING IS HIS VIEW THAT ANTI-SANDINISTAS NEED TO BE UNIFIED. LOPEZ HAS RECEIVED SOME FEELERS FROM EDEN PASTORA AND, IN EARLIER MEETING WITH AMBASSADOR AND PRESIDENT SUAZO ON APRIL 14, BOTH LOPEZ AND SUAZO EXPRESSED RESERVATIONS ABOUT FON LEADERSHIP, ESPECIALLY FORMER NATIONAL GUARDSMAN ENRIQUE BERMUDEZ. IT WILL BE INTERESTING TO SEE IF THESE IDEAS PERSIST AS LOPEZ DELVES MORE DEEPLY INTO THESE MATTERS. HIS THINKING APPEARS IN PART TO BE BASED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT PASTORA MAY NOT BE RECEIVING USG SUPPORT AT THIS TIME. **NEGROPONTE**
