The Institute was created by Congress in 1985 to promote the non-violent resolution of international conflict through negotiation and mediation. In addition, the organization awards scholarships and grants to scholars and leaders of peace from the United States and abroad. (See letter opposite.) Recently, Ambassador Lewis was appointed President of the Institute. The other honoree, Morry Liebman, is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Strategy Information Center and Center for Strategic Studies at Georgetown University.
