~~On September 29, 1988,~~ at the Capital Hilton, we will be holding the seventh annual Bryce Harlow Award dinner.



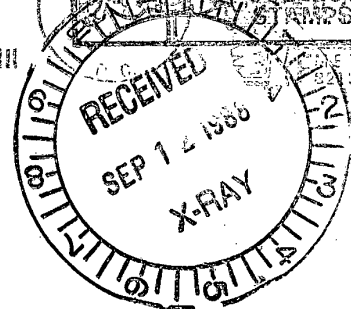
