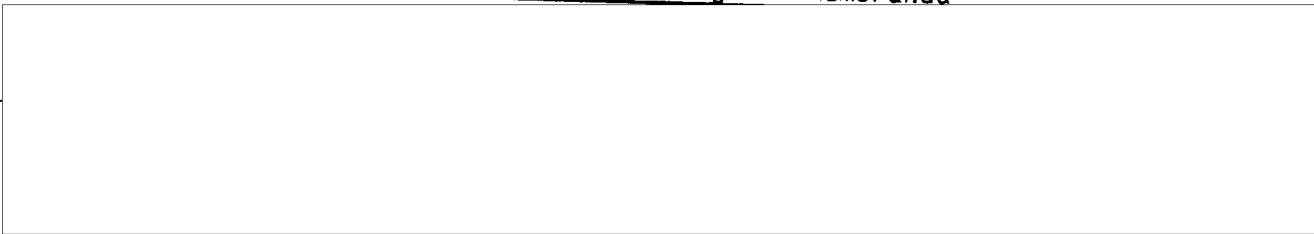
DCI and DDCI Support


Outside Sampling
