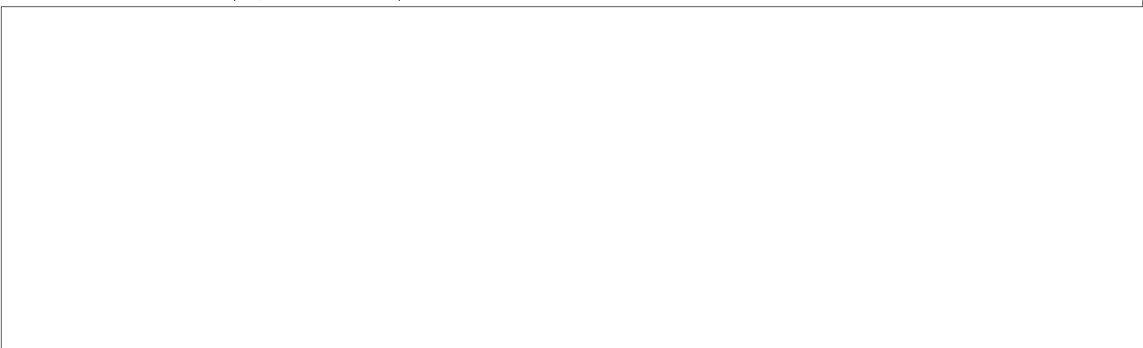

 SUBJECT: MEDIA REACTION - FREE TRADE

1. THREE CANADIAN NEWSPAPERS MAY 18 REACTED TO U.S. SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE HEARINGS ON THE FREE TRADE DEAL. PARTIAL TEXT FOLLOWS:

2. THE TORONTO STAR CARRIED 2 COLUMNS. THE FIRST, TITLED "TUGGING THS WAY AND THAT OVER TRADE DEAL" WAS BY COMMENTATOR DAVID CRANE. "...THE MULRONEY GOVERNMENT IS CLEARLY CAUGHT BETWEEN THE DEMANDS OF THE U.S. CONGRESS ON ONE SIDE AND THE PROVINCES ON THE OTHER...THE PROPOSED FREE TRADE DEAL RAISES SEVERAL OTHER QUESTIONS. WHAT EVIDENCE OF PROVINCIAL COMPLIANCE WILL SATISFY THE U.S.? WILL THE AMERICANS WANT A RESOLUTION OR OTHER LEGISLATIVE MEASURE ADOPTED BY EACH PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE?...WILL THE LEGISLATION ALTER CANADA'S FEDERAL SYSTEM, MAKING IT MORE LIKE THE U.S. SYSTEM IN WHICH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAS BROADER POWERS? UNDER THE SOFTWOOD LUMBER PROVISIONS, FOR EXAMPLE, CHANGES IN PROVINCIAL FORESTRY POLICIES SUCH AS ROYALTY OR STUMPAGE FEES ON TREES CUT ON PROVINCIAL LANDS CAN ONLY BE MADE WITH U.S. APPROVAL..."

2. ROSEMARY SPEIRS, IN "WHO HOLDS TRUMP IN THE FREE TRADE GAME?" OPINED : "...LATER MONDAY, SENATOR LLOYD BENTSEN SAID THE U.S. SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE HAD VOTED TO BLOCK FREE TRADE UNLESS THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT CAN GIVE ASSURANCES THAT THE PROVINCES ARE BOUND TO THE TERMS OF THE DEAL. COMBINED WITH (ONTARIO PREMIER) PETERSON'S NAY, CROSBIE HAS NO CHOICE -- HE HAS TO

LEGISLATE COMPLIANCE...DIRECT DEFIANCE HAS ITS DOWNSIDE FOR PETERSON, HOWEVER. OUTSIDE ONTARIO, THE MOVE WOULD NO DOUBT ANGER WESTERNERS, WHO WANT TO SELL MORE OIL TO THE AMERICANS, AND QUEBECERS, WHO ENVISION RICHES FROM BIG HYDRO DEALS..."

3. AN EDITORIAL IN THE OTTAWA CITIZEN WAS TITLED "PETERSON HANDED FREE-TRADE GRENADE:" "...THE ONTARIO GOVERNMENT BELIEVES THERE ARE STRONG LEGAL GROUNDS TO OPPOSE SUCH IMPLEMENTING LEGISLATION; IT WOULD CHANGE THE FORMAL DIVISION OF POWERS BETWEEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND THE PROVINCES MORE THAN THE COURTS HAVE BEEN WILLING TO ALLOW IN PAST CASES. FORTUNATELY, THOUGH, PETERSON DOES NOT WANT TO BE KNOWN AS THE LEADER WHO DESTROYED AN HISTORIC DEAL, SUPPORTED BY ALL THE OTHER PROVINCES, SIMPLY TO PROTECT A SMALL DOMESTIC MONOPOLY. AS A RESULT, HE HAS SUGGESTED HE WOULD NOT CHALLENGE THE PACT IN COURT IF HE COULD NOT ENLIST SOME OTHER PROVINCES TO SUPPORT HIS CASE.

4. "THAT STANCE WAS CHOSEN TO KEEP THE OPTION OF QUIETLY ACQUIESCING TO THE WISHES OF THE REST OF THE COUNTRY. THE RATIONALE WOULD BE THAT ONTARIO COULDN'T, OR SHOULD'T, STOP FREE TRADE ALL BY ITSELF. NOW, HOWEVER, THE U.S. SENATE HAS GIVEN PETERSON THE UNWANTED OPTION OF BEING ABLE TO TORPEDO THE DEAL SIMPLY BY REFUSING TO GIVE AN ASSURANCE OF COMPLIANCE. CANADA'S FUTURE MAY WELL DEPEND OF PETERSON'S ABILITY TO RESIST THE REACTIONARY FORCES OF PAROCHIAL POLITICS."

5. THE MONTREAL GAZETTE CARRIED THE EDITORIAL "LET'S ASK THE JUDGES." "...MR. PETERSON IS NOT CONCERNED ONLY ABOUT PROTECTING ONTARIO'S WINE INDUSTRY. HE DISLIKES THE WHOLE TRADE DEAL BECAUSE HE THINKS IT IS FUNDAMENTALLY FLAWED. IN THAT, HE IS ABSOLUTELY RIGHT. THIS DEAL WOULD DRASTICALLY ERODE CANADA'S SOVEREIGNTY, CURTAILING OUR ABILITY TO SET POLICY ON ENERGY, REGIONAL AND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT, FOREIGN INVESTMENT, PROBABLY CULTURE AND EVENTUALLY SOCIAL POLICY..."
