 ORGANIZATION CONTROLLED BY THE FMLN AND THE
 ESTABLISHMENT OF LINKAGES BETWEEN THIS NEW FRONT
 ORGANIZATION AND INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY AND WOMEN'S
 ORGANIZATIONS. POSTS SHOULD BE ALERT TO THE
 APPEARANCE OF NEW SALVADORAN FRONT GROUPS. END
 SUMMARY.

2. ACCORDING TO DOCUMENTS CAPTURED FEBRUARY 10 BEING
 SENT FROM ERP CHIEF JOAQUIN VILLALOBOS TO FARN CHIEF
 FERMAN CIENFUEGOS, AS PART OF ITS EXPANDED POLITICAL
 WORK TO BRING ABOUT AN INSURRECTION IN 1988-89, THE
 FMLN INTENDS TO ESTABLISH MULTIPLE WOMEN'S
 ORGANIZATIONS AND A NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF THESE
 SUBORDINATE UNITS. OVER THE WEEKEND OF MARCH 5-6
 FOUR PREVIOUSLY UNKNOWN WOMEN'S ORGANIZATIONS EMERGED
 AND FORMED CONAMUS (COORDINADORA NACIONAL DE MUJERES

3. ON MARCH 8 A FULL PAGE PAID ADVERTISEMENT IN EL MUNDO NEWSPAPER LISTED 39 U.S. INDIVIDUALS AND 27 U.S. ORGANIZATIONS AGAINST THE REAGAN ADMINISTRATION AND IN SUPPORT OF SALVADORAN WOMEN. THE AD EXPRESSES CONCERN ABOUT THREE FMLN FRONT ORGANIZATIONS: FECMAFAM (THE ASSOCIATION OF THE THREE MOTHERS ORGANIZATIONS), COMADRES (THE FARN-FACTION MOTHERS ORGANIZATION) AND THE UNTS LABOR GROUPS FUSS-FESTIAVTSCES. THE U.S. ORGANIZATIONS LISTED IN THE AD INCLUDE SIX CHAPTERS OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR WOMEN (NOW)(MASSACHUSETTS, VERMONT, AND ILLINOIS).
4. NAMES ON THE LIST OF ENDORSERS INCLUDE SEVERAL KNOWN TO BE ACTIVE IN THE U.S. FPL-SUPPORT ORGANIZATION NEW EL SALVADOR TODAY (NEST) RUN BY FORMER BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA MAYOR GUS NEWPORT (NEWPORT IS VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE SOVIET FRONT WORLD PEACE COUNCIL AND CO-CHAIRMAN OF THE U.S. PEACE COUNCIL). NEST HAS ESTABLISHED INFORMAL SISTER CITY LINKAGES WITH FOUR FPL-INFLUENCED TOWNS AND THE U.S. CITIES OF BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA; MADISON, WISCONSIN; BALTIMORE, MARYLAND AND CAMBRIDGE, MASSACHUSETTS. THE INDIVIDUALS WHO SIGNED THE WOMEN'S SOLIDARITY ADVERTISEMENT INCLUDE SOME WHO HELPED ESTABLISH THE CAMBRIDGE NEST OPERATION.
5. THE CAPTURED DOCUMENT DISCUSSES OPENLY, USING THE FORMAL NAMES, A NUMBER OF ORGANIZATIONS AS POTENTIAL SOURCES OF RECRUITS AND ORGANIZATIONAL HELP REFERRING TO THEM AS FMLN RELATED ENTITIES. THESE ORGANIZATIONS INCLUDE:
- A) ANDES 21 DE JUNIO - NATIONAL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION
 - B) AGEUS - UNIVERSITY OF EL SALVADOR GENERAL ASSEMBLY
 - C) FENASTRAS - UNTS-AFFILIATED AND FARN-CONTROLLED
 - LABOR UNION (WITH OFFICE IN WASHINGTON, D.C.
 - HEADQUARTERS OF INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MACHINISTS)
 - D) COMADRES
 - E) CRIPDES - DISPLACED PERSONS ORGANIZATION
 - F) CNR - REGUGEES ORGANIZATION

6. THE DOCUMENT STATES THAT:
- THE MOVEMENT SHOULD BE DIRECTED BY FEMALE FMLN MEMBERS.
 - THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION SHOULD PROLIFERATE SUBORDINATE AFFILIATES.
 - THE ORGANIZATION SHOULD COLLABORATE WITH THE UNTS LABOR FRONT IN ORDER TO EXPAND FMLN OPERATIONS THROUGH THE NEW UMBRELLA FRONT ORGANIZATION "MOVEMENT FOR BREAD, LAND, WORK, AND LIBERTY FOR THE COUNTRY" (THIS ORGANIZATION IS DISCUSSED IN THE DOCUMENTS AS

THE MARCH 8 PAID ADVERTISEMENT. WHILE THE DOCUMENT
ON THE WOMEN'S ORGANIZATION IS UNDATED, THE OTHER
DOCUMENTS CAPTURED ON FEBRUARY 10 ALL CARRY JANUARY
1988 DATES. IT IS REASONABLE TO ASSUME THAT THE U.S.
COMADRES REPRESENTATIVE WHO RECENTLY RETURNED
ILLEGALLY TO THE U.S. CARRIED THIS PROPOSAL WITH HER
AND THAT SHE HAS BEEN INSTRUMENTAL IN MANIPULATING
THE U.S. CITIZENS AND ORGANIZATIONS WHICH APPEARED IN
THE MARCH 8 AD.

OFFICIALS OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR WOMEN WERE
INVOLVED IN THE APRIL 25, 1986 MOBILIZATION ACTIONS
FOR PEACE, JOBS AND JUSTICE IN CENTRAL AMERICA AND
SOUTH AFRICA. THE MOBILIZATION PROGRAM COMMITTEE FOR
THAT EVENT INCLUDED THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE
