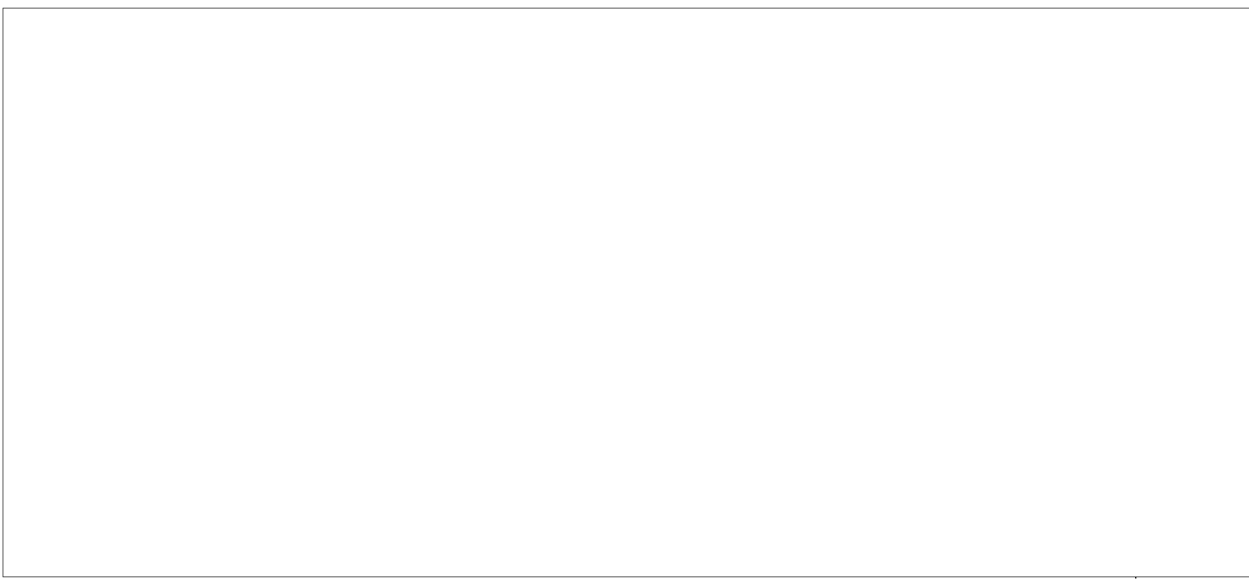

SUBJECT: Meeting with the SSCI Senior Staff, 1 February 1988

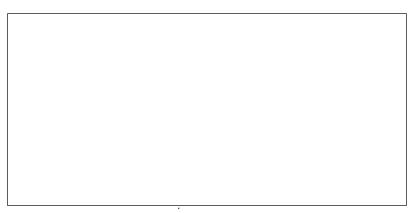

Britt Snider and Keith Hall came in late and George Tenet was present during the discussion of INF matters. John Helgerson, [redacted] represented the Office of Congressional Affairs. -- Holmes informed us that the Committee's hearings on the statutory IG will be open.

-- Senator Glenn's staff is looking for a vehicle for a GAO amendment. S-1721 is a likely candidate.

-- The staff expressed irritation that lobbyists called Committee staffers on open lines promoting a positive vote at the Committee's 3 February covert action hearing. The staffers blamed the Department of State. (Action: [Redacted] to alert State and DO.)
