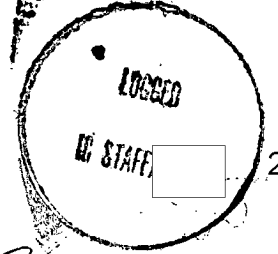

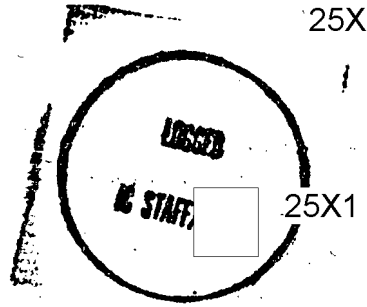

DCI and DDCI Support

Bob Blackwell briefed the Vice President on recent developments in the Soviet Union. (NIO/USSR)

Carl Ford and Gordon Oehler attended a Policy Review Group meeting regarding US Liberalization of Telecommunications Exports to China. (NIO/East Asia)

Deane Hoffmann spoke on economic reform in the USSR and Bob Blackwell spoke on political changes at the Security Affairs Support Association Fall '88 Symposium at the Department of State. (NIO/Economics and NIO/USSR)

Estimates and Intelligence Memoranda

Murat Natirboff chaired three well attended Community seminars on implications of intelligence obtained from INF inspections. These seminars will support preparation of an estimate on intelligence the US acquired in the USSR during on-site inspections, as well as an estimate of what the Soviets acquired in the US. (NIO/Foreign Denial and Intelligence Activities)

Intelligence Community

Larry Budge is hosting a series of seminars on a new book by S. G. Gorshkov, Admiral of the Fleet of the Soviet Union, entitled The Navy: Roles, Development Procedures, Employment. The book introduces important new doctrine. (NIO/General Purpose Forces)
