Procurement of ADPE of Foreign Manufacture

Background:

- STAT 21 April 1981

Memo to [] from [] Subject: ADPE Procurement Policy

Discusses Possible: Alteration of equipment for surveillance or disruptive purposes during manufacture; embargo of spares, upgrades, engineering changes, or follow-on technology; alteration of equipment for surveillance or disruptive purposes during use; difficulty in access to engineering/manufacturing personnel; necessity for use of foreign national engineering/manufacturing specialists for maintenance.

Proposes Policy: "...that ADPE which is substantially of foreign manufacture will not be procured for use in ODP computer networks."

*Defined as ADPE when is or consists of critical subsystems or final assembly performed by a foreign manufacturer.

Memo from [redacted] to D/L transmitting copy of Ense memo with annotated comments.

*Corrects memo to state that D/L sets procurement policy, not D/ODP.

Problems:

*Protests undoubtedly will result when we begin excluding various manufacturers.

*ODP/OS must do additional homework for issuance of HR.

*Board or panel, plus other apparatus necessary to make this new policy work, must be established.

*May be inconsistent with terms of DPA from GSA.

*May be inconsistent with Brooks Bill.

*May draw Congressional heat as violation of international trade agreement.

Action:

1. Establish working group to resolve above problems and make final recommendation to D/L. Should include Counsel, ODP, OS, ADP&E/PD. *also ol oc*
2. Issue PN based on working group recommendations.
3. Issue HR to reflect working group recommendations.
