9. Delivered to Fred Mesmer, Senate Immigration Subcommittee staff, a blind memorandum on [redacted]. Also talked with Mesmer about H. R. 4253, a bill to waive the ten year naturalization restriction on former Communist Party members. Mesmer indicated (somewhat contrary to his position on a similar question last year) that if the beneficiary were otherwise eligible for naturalization, this bill might well pass without Constitutional objections being made.
