1. Talked with Julius Kahn, Senate Government Operations Subcommittee on Reorganization, and suggested that Senator Hubert Humphrey's tapes of his interview with Krushchev would be helpful [redacted] 25X1

Dr. Scoville called regarding the letter from Spencer Beresford (House Sciences and Astronautics Committee) asking for information as a follow-up to the briefing on the Soviet rocket and missile programs. Scoville explained that he would be unable to answer the first question relating to the 1959 tests without discussing TOP SECRET information. After discussing this with Beresford it was agreed that we would exclude this item from the questions and deal with it in a separate document which would not be retained by the Committee.

4. Telephoned Colonel Rettgers, Army L&L, concerning his meeting with Senator John F. Kennedy (D., Mass.) on the [redacted] case. Rettgers met with Senator Kennedy and his Administrative Assistant at 6:30 on Friday and discussed the case along the same lines used by Mr. Warner in other meetings with members of Congress. Senator Kennedy and the Administrative Assistant appeared more than satisfied. 25X1
