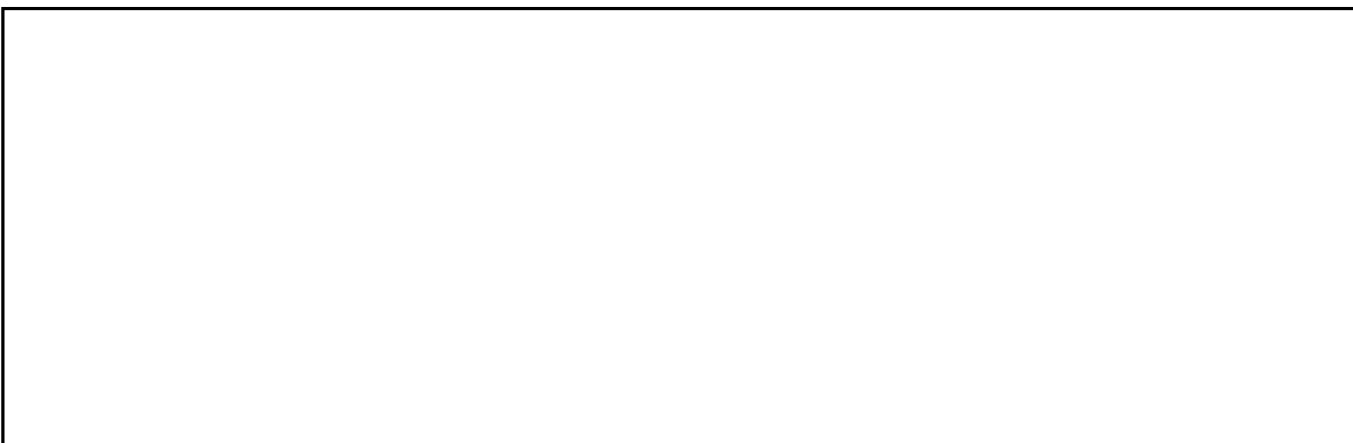

25X1 6. Per our inquiry [ ] in Security advised that Mr. Finan, Assistant Director for Management and Organization, Bureau of the Budget, and Herbert N. Jasper, an employee in his division, have both been cleared through TOP SECRET.

25X1 7. Talked further with Colonel Schuppen on the staff of the House Science and Astronautics Committee concerning an Agency appearance in the dissemination of scientific information hearings. It was agreed that we would work toward the date of 17 June contacting them further upon Mr. Borel's return on Wednesday. Schuppen indicated that the Committee might also talk with [ ] on the subject of the use of high speed computers for mechanical translation. He is aware that [ ] is currently out of the country. 25X1

8. Mr. Spencer Beresford, counsel for the House Science and Astronautics Committee, called to confirm our appearance before the Committee on Friday, 5 June. Our Agency was originally scheduled for 15 May but was postponed upon three occasions at the instance of the Committee. Dr. Scoville will continue the briefing on Soviet missile and rocket programs which were not completed on 24 February. He will also cover the Soviet moon probe.
