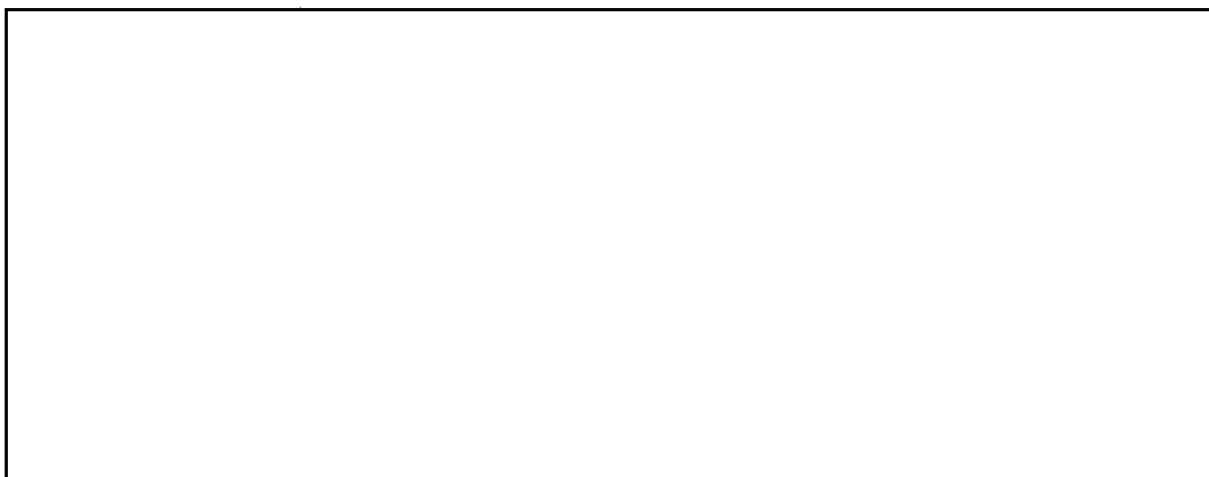

6. [redacted] (OSI) and [redacted] met with Spencer Beresford, counsel of the House Committee on Science and Astronautics, to discuss Congressman Anfuso's request that the Agency submit to his Subcommittee a statement containing a comparison of U. S. and Soviet space technology for the purpose of assessing the Soviet lunik shot. It was determined from Mr. Beresford that Anfuso does not intend to develop the subject of space technology generally in his Subcommittee hearings beginning on 28 May, but desires a brief statement to which he might refer. The statement would contain conclusions pertaining to Soviet missile tests and tracking guidance. [redacted] pointed out the problems involved in our providing a statement containing comparisons and added that while we could provide a statement on Soviet capabilities in this area we could not provide the comparison Anfuso requested. It was agreed that we would provide such a statement by 27 May in the hope that it would be acceptable to Congressman Anfuso. Beresford said he thought the statement would be accepted by Anfuso but if it was not, the Congressman would probably call the Director to discuss the matter further.

that he had made efforts to obtain support for this program from various publishing houses and other interested organizations, but since most of them are directly involved in the program they felt any effort they might make would be considered as self-serving. Lehman feels that support from the Director would be of great value to this program. The program is administered in USIA by Mr. Robert M. Beers, Acting Chief of the Informational Media Guaranty Division (x5217). Mr. Lehman was advised that we would look into the matter and be back in touch with him.

6. Spencer Beresford, Counsel for the House Science and Astronautics Committee, called to change the date of our appearance before the Committee from 1 June to 5 June. He said he had discussed our appearance with Chairman Brooks and learned that the Chairman would be out of town on the 1st. Dr. Scoville has been advised of this change in date.

7. Mr. Beresford also stated that Congressman Anfuso's subcommittee will begin hearings on 28 May on the Soviet lunik shot. Anfuso's subcommittee will be concerned only with the shot itself and not with any background information. Anfuso would like to have the Agency submit a short paper (2-3 pages) containing a comparison of Soviet and United States space technology. The purpose of the paper would be to permit the subcommittee to better assess material concerning the Soviet shot. This has been discussed with (OSI).
