Called Mr. John Lehman, Clerk of the Joint Economic Committee, to advise him that the Director was currently on leave; however, we were confident that he would appear at the Committee's fall hearings on the Comparison of the U. S. and Soviet Economies. We are to check with Mr. Lehman again upon the Director's return. At that time he will draft a formal invitation for the Chairman's signature. When queried as to any thoughts which he might have regarding the Director's remarks, Lehman suggested that the Director stress the importance of the communist economic program using whatever illustrations he might feel appropriate. He felt that the Director might cover what we do and do not understand about the nature of this threat. [redacted] has been alerted to this appearance.

11. [redacted] Security requested information as to the status of H. R. 3151. He was advised that this bill which would require Federal withholding of tax for cities as well as states and territories was reported by the House Ways and Means Committee on August 11. No action has been taken on the bill on the floor of the House as yet.

12. Spencer Beresford, Counsel for the House Committee on Science and Astronautics, called to advise that the Committee had published a report on the First Soviet Moon Rocket. He is making copies available to us.

13. Mr. Ben Mandel, Research Director for the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee, called to discuss a project which he thought would be useful to both the Agency and the Subcommittee. [redacted]
