5. Talked with Harry Carter, General Counsel, USIA, concerning their mechanism for handling the CONGRESSIONAL RECORD and other congressional matters having possible impact abroad. He mentioned that VOA has a correspondent (much as a newspaper does who circulates on the Hill). Within the Legislative Liaison staff they have two people who review the RECORD putting out a short daily summary and otherwise forwarding items of interest throughout USIA.

6. Talked with [] in OCI who advised that Dick Courtney in IR, State Department, had contacted him informally asking for suggestions as to witnesses on Communism in Mexico. After checking further, [] advised that the query had come from HCUA and had been passed to Courtney from Paul J. Burns on the staff of Consular and Security Affairs.

7. John Hogland of State Department Congressional Liaison called to say that Senator J. W. Fulbright had inquired why one [] had been denied a visa. [] come from [] was merely alerting us to the fact that they might wish to ask us to accompany them if they had to see Fulbright on this.
