25X1 1. [redacted] By prior arrangement, Messrs. [redacted]  
 25X1 [redacted] and John S. Warner met with the Inter-American  
 Affairs Subcommittee of House Foreign Affairs for an informal briefing  
 session on Cuba. Members of the Subcommittee present were Dante B.  
 Faccell and Armistead L. Selden, Jr. (Chairman). Other members from  
 the full Committee present were: John L. Pilcher, William T. Murphy,  
 Frances P. Bolton, Walter H. Judd, James G. Fulton, and Laurence  
 Curtis. Present from the staff were: Boyd Crawford, Roy Bullock,  
 Henry Billingsley, and Franklin J. Schupp. No record was kept and  
 25X1 after a brief statement by [redacted] there was an extended question  
 and answer period. Some of the questions tended to bring in policy  
 matters but at each point where we demurred because of policy aspects  
 which were of no concern to the Agency, the questions were withdrawn  
 and there was no difficulty on this point. The members seemed satisfied  
 at the information but are obviously frustrated and are seeking answers  
 on how to solve the problem.

25X1 2. [redacted] Talked with Gene Dawson in the  
 office of Senator Capehart to advise him I had interviewed [redacted]  
 25X1 [redacted] to assure her that the Agency was not blackballing her in her  
 efforts of the last seven years to secure better positions in the Pentagon.  
 Dawson was appreciative of my taking the time to interview her and of  
 my call to him.

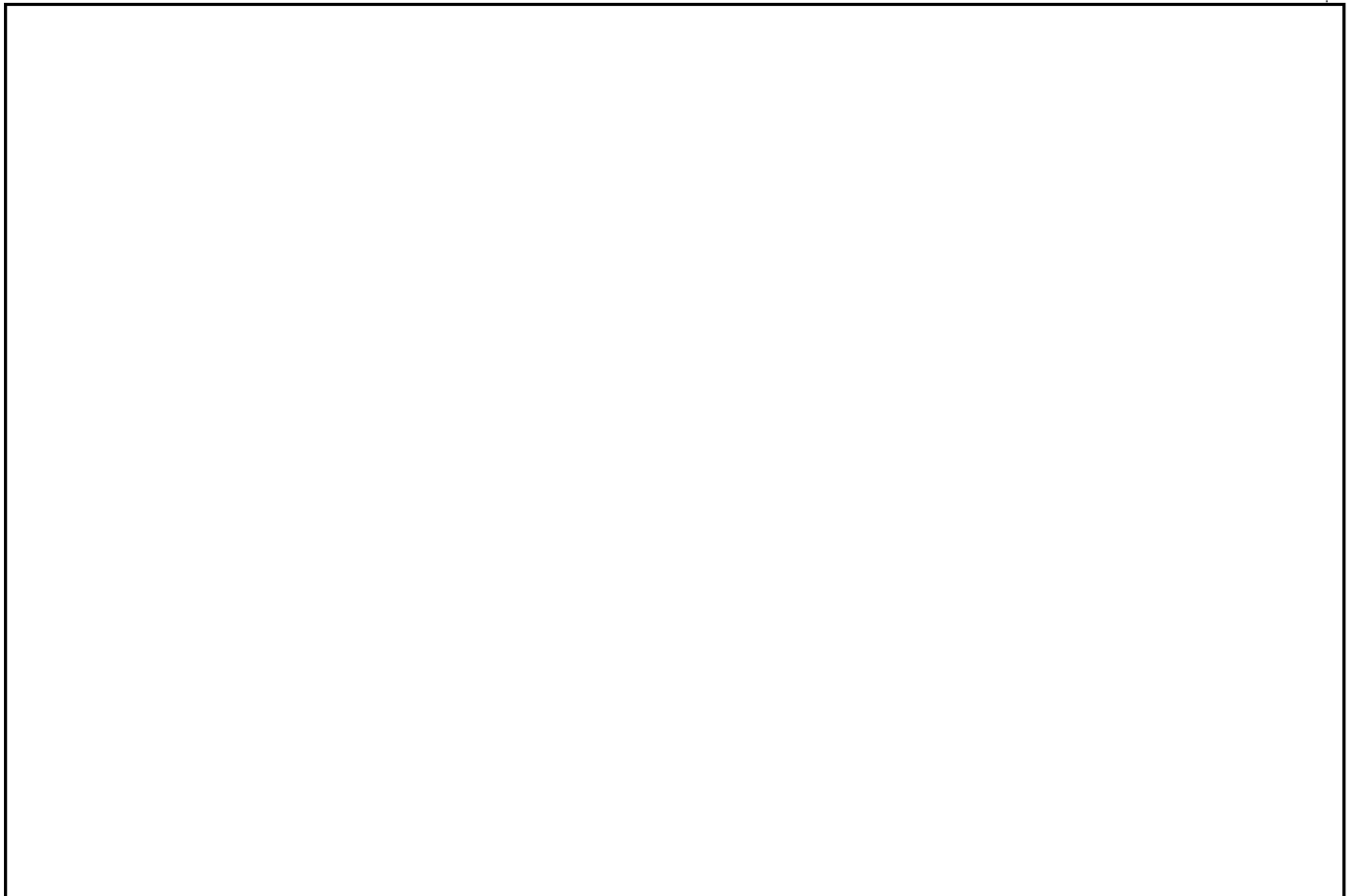
