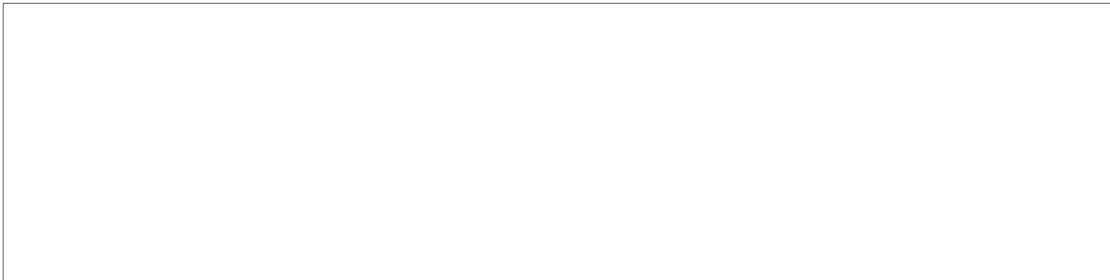

The Panel met on 30 November - 1 December and received briefings on and discussed the following subjects:

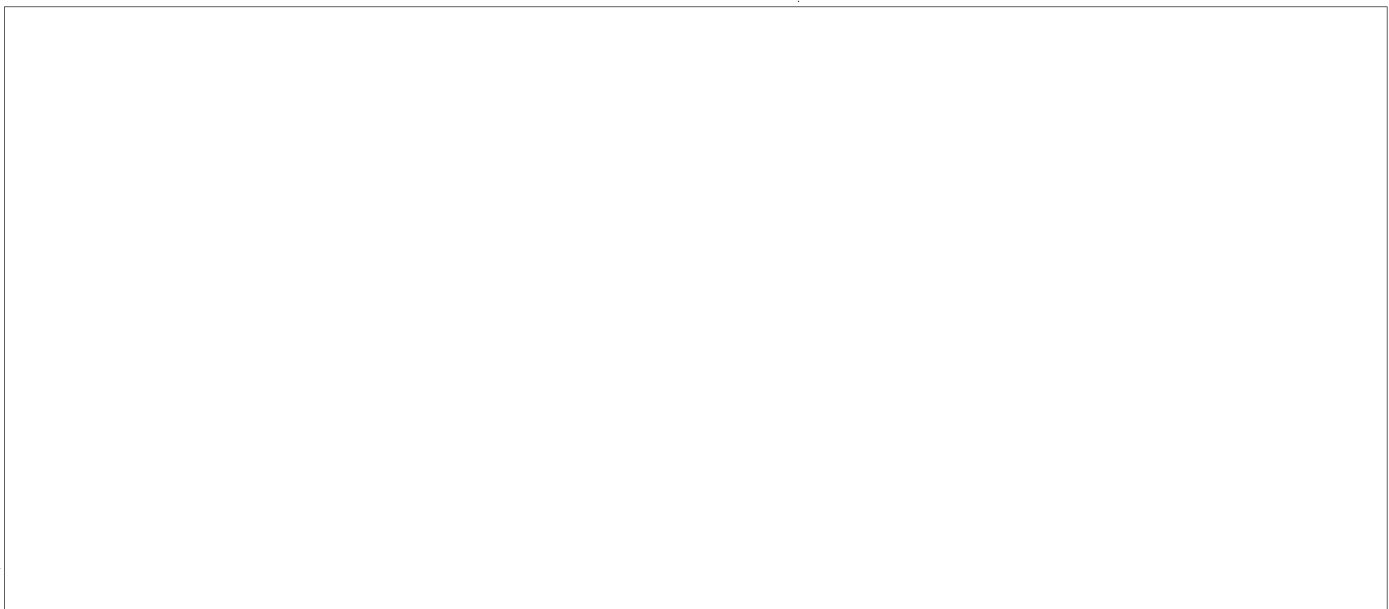
