Continuing topics discussed were: Chemical Warfare; and Technology Transfer.

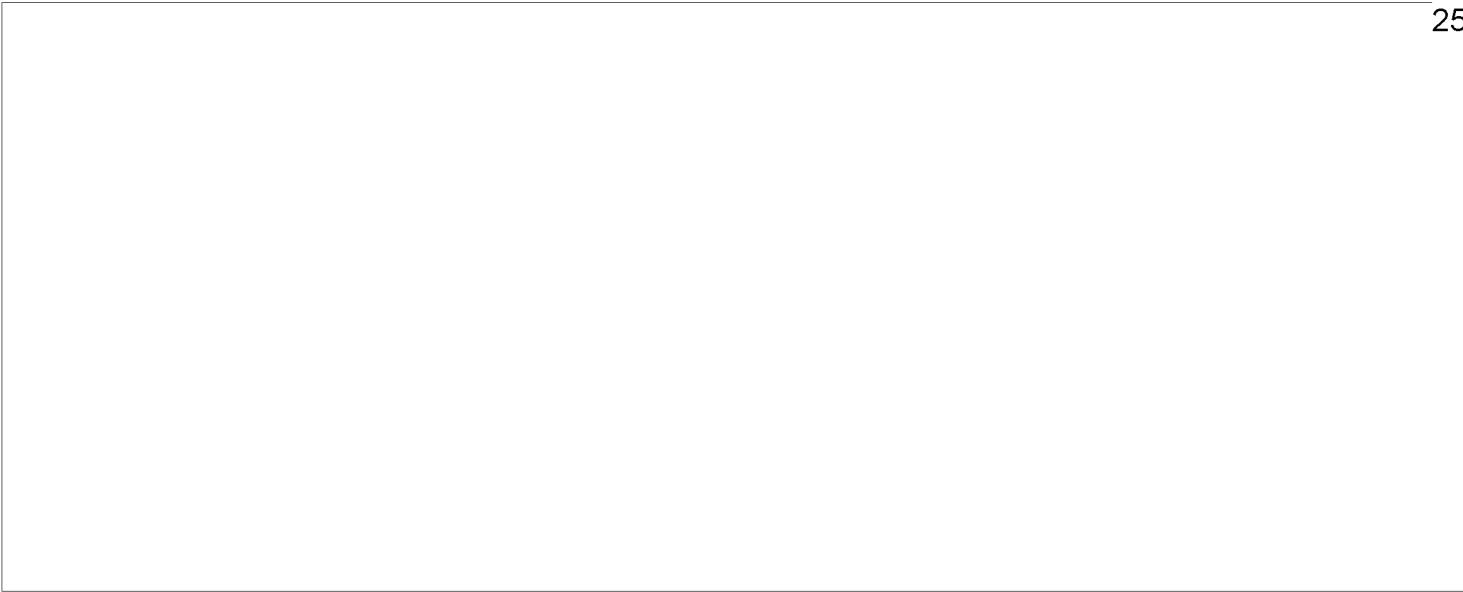

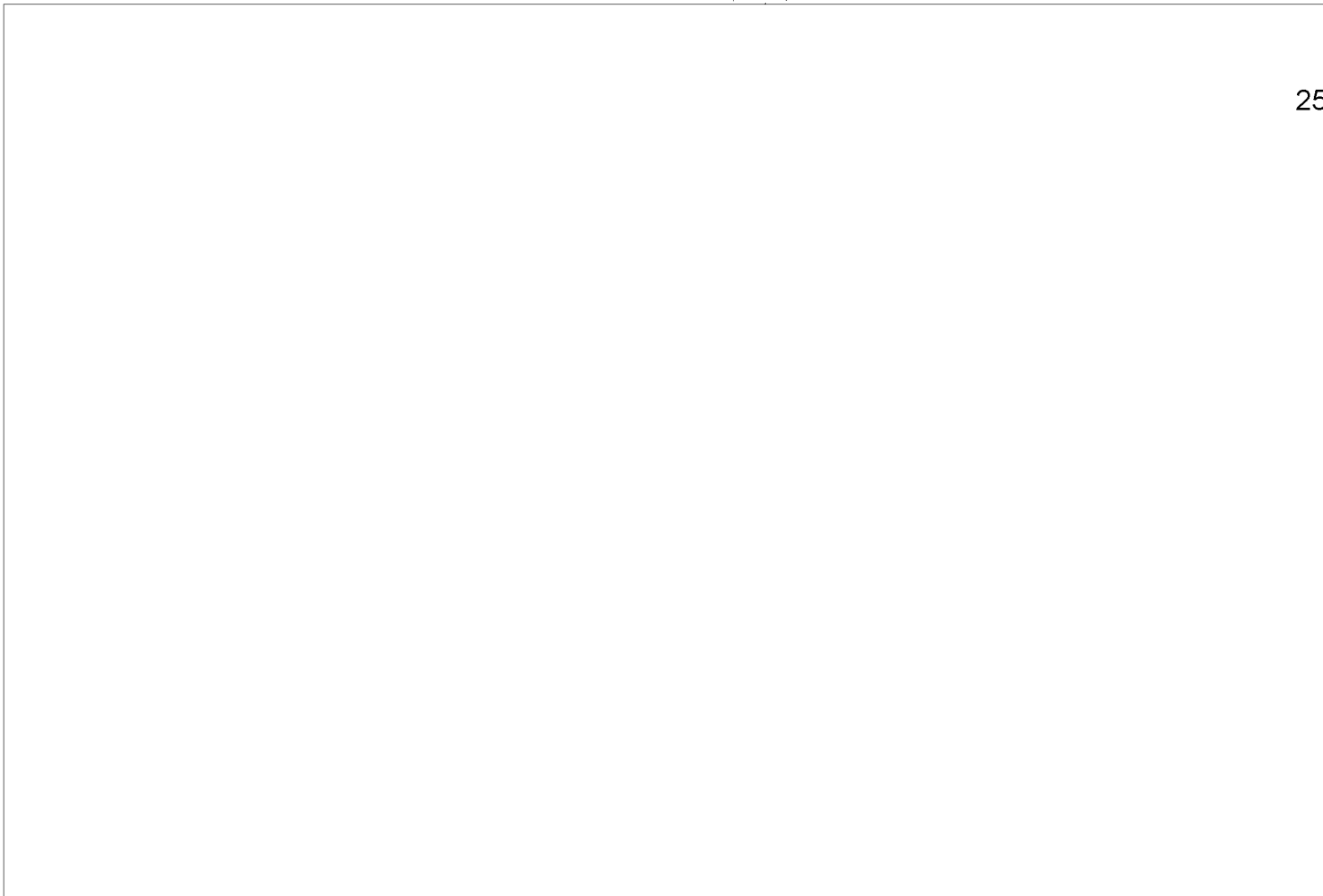

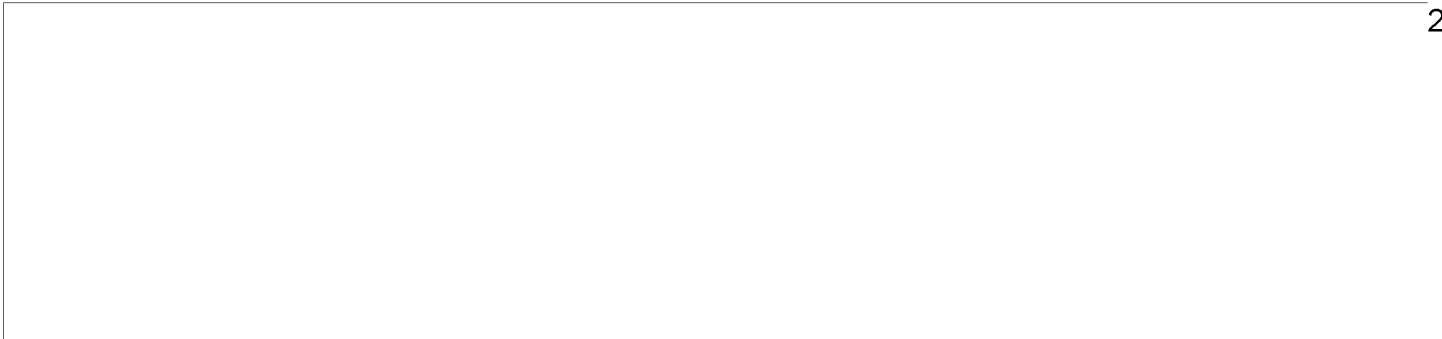
