In reviewing the minutes of the AI Applications Working Group I think I detect one gap which is fundamental to the way we both view the problem. All of the requirements identified were based on the premise that there is a collection of data on which to operate. The problem is that this is not true today. One issue which must be addressed as an AI requirement is how we can build the knowledge bases against which we can apply our analytic tools.

I also see in the user responses the lack of understanding between data and intelligence or knowledge. That concept needs to be pushed.
